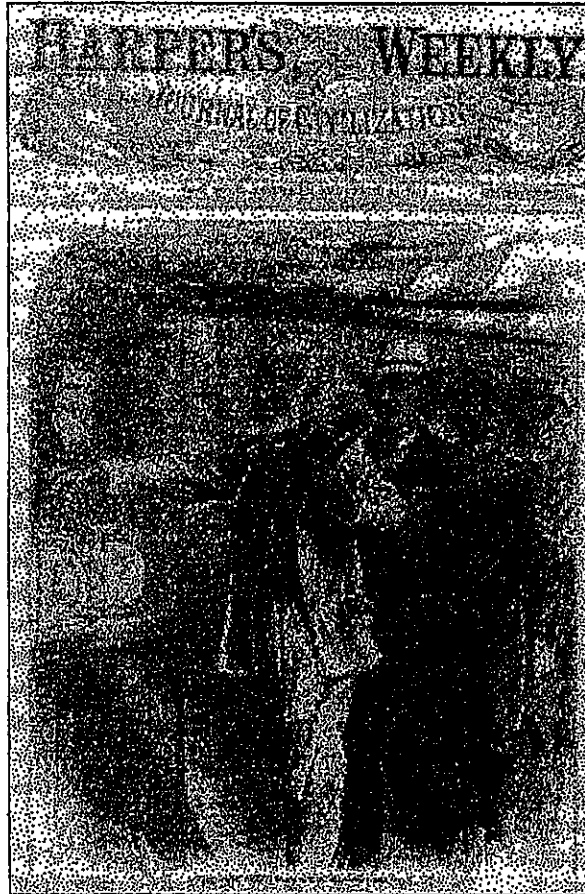

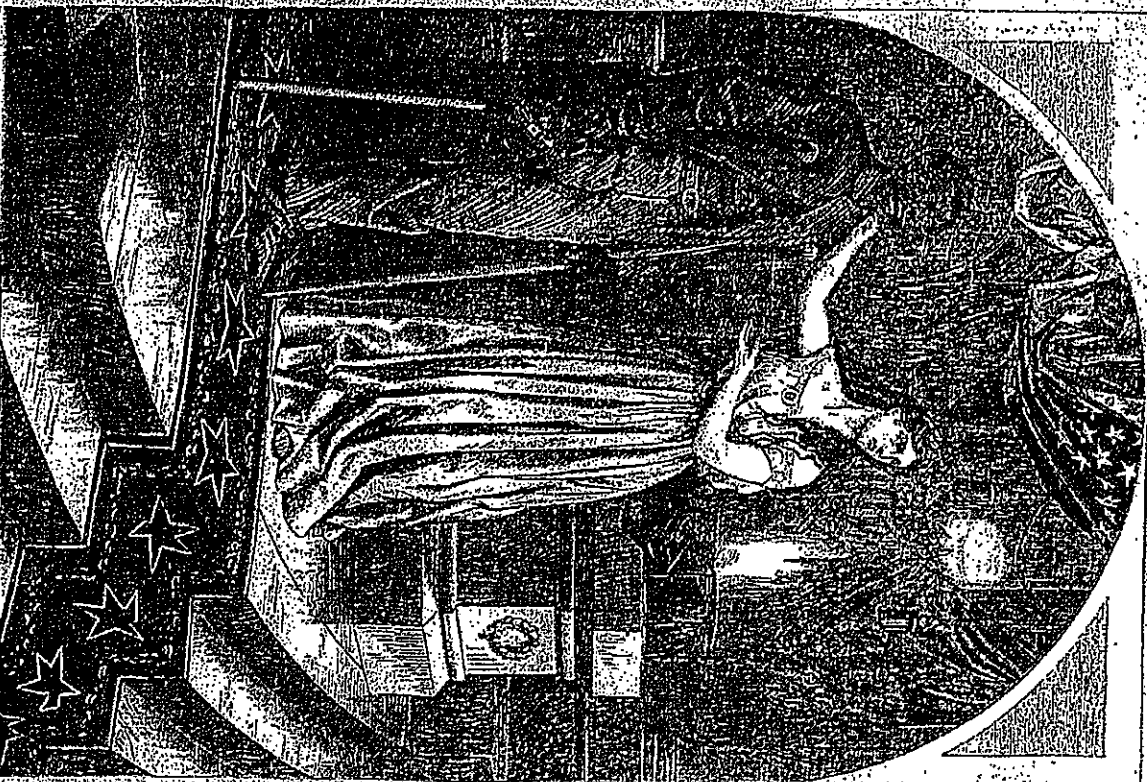

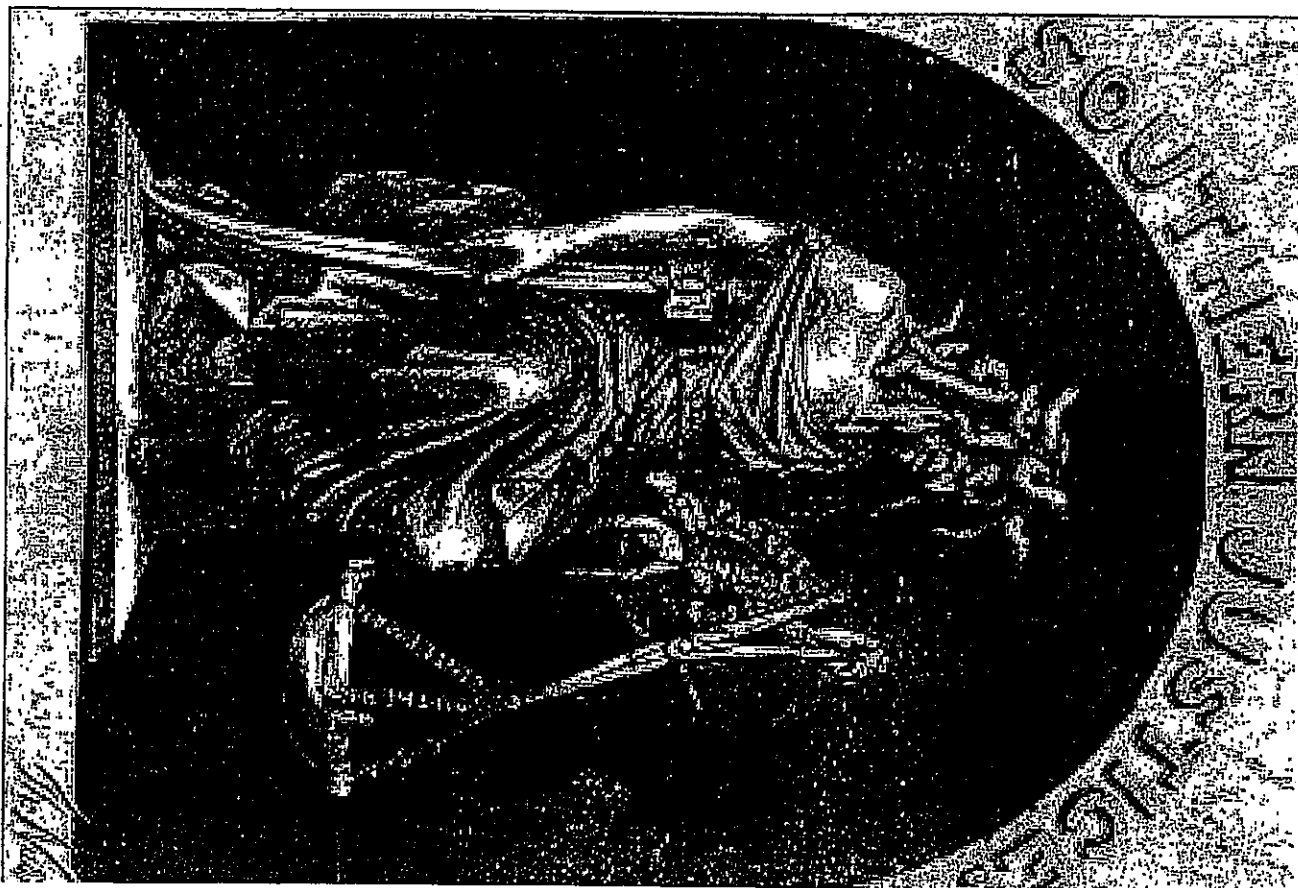
- When was this illustration published? Where? In what part of the magazine?

- How does this cartoon illustrate the success of Reconstruction?



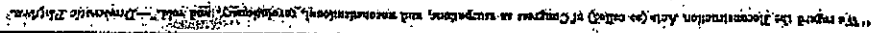

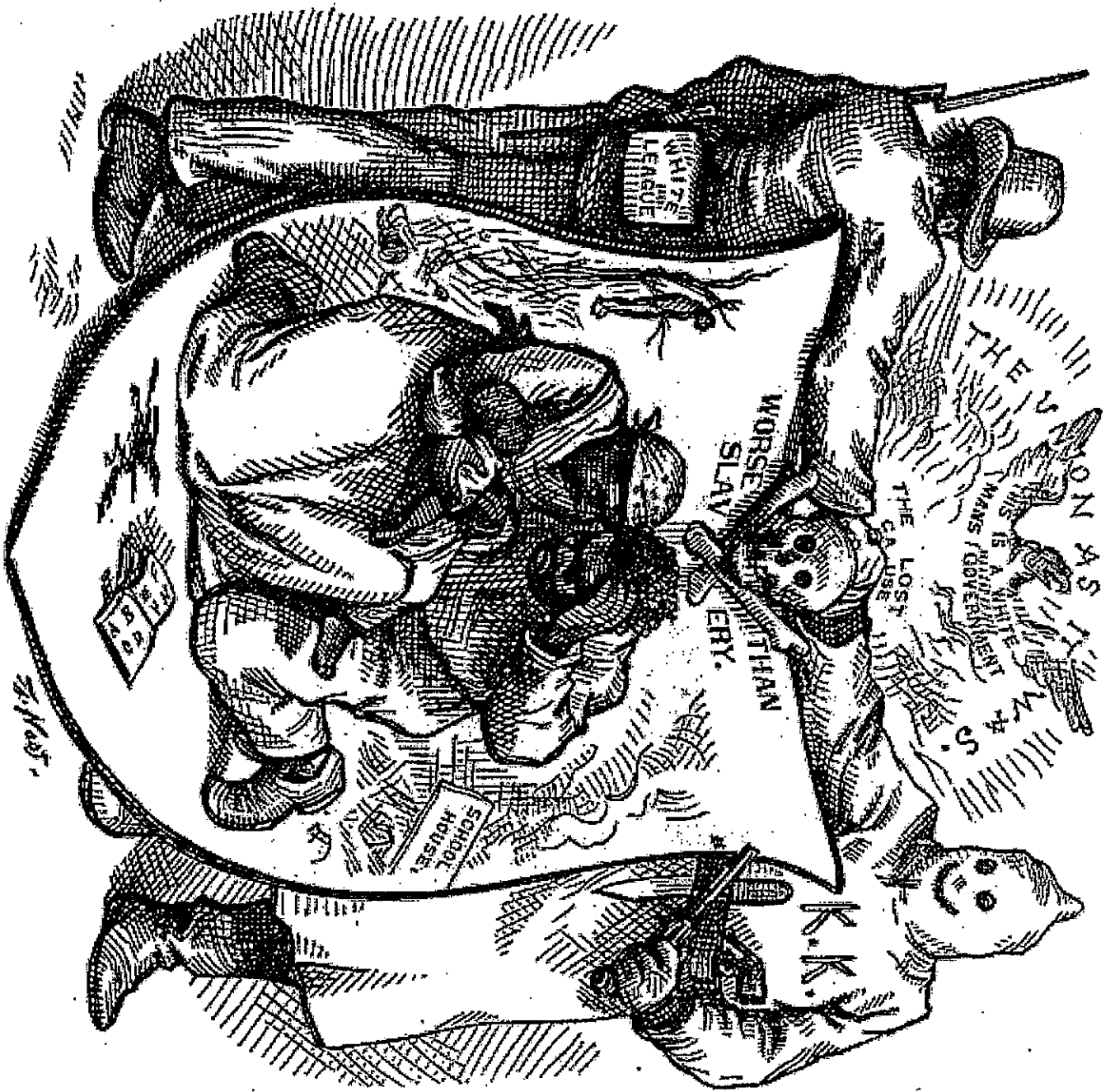

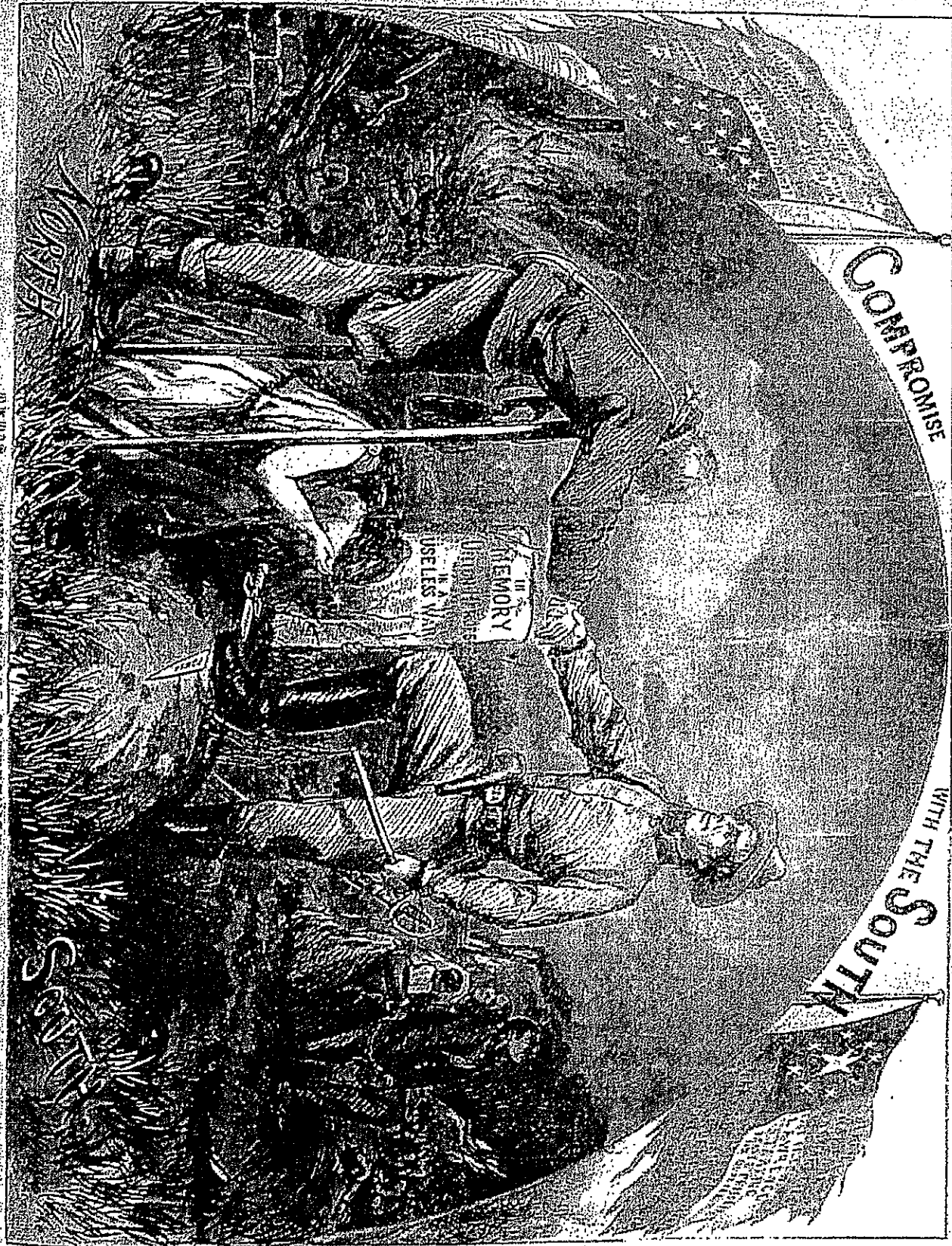
