*(Come up with an interview scene where you are both playing **characters that are not yourselves**. You will have an opportunity to be both the interviewer and the interviewee.*

*****For the script you write you are the interviewee!***

Tips:

- The interviewer can be as interesting as the interviewee
- Don't waste time with boring/general questions, start from a specific viewpoint or have an interesting newsworthy item to discuss

Example:

boring/general: Who are you?

Interesting: I'm here with Doctor Flugenhammer and he is going to discuss his amazing age reversing formula creating from rotting banana peel extract!

TEN IDEAS FOR QUESTIONS OR EVENTS DURING THE INTERVIEW (10 points)

1. Questions about their life
2. Simple and easy questions but meaningful
3. Catchy questions that can bring attention to audience
4. Show a bit of humor that can change the ambience
5. Loud and emphasis for every point.
6. Asking questions in a formal matter but in some ways casual
7. Put an emotional scene
8. Questions that considers ones opinion
9. Sometimes mocking time to time for humor
10. Conclusion with a polite manner

ENDING (2 points)

For this interview, I will conclude it with a finishing statement and a conclude it with a wrapping up statement. Like conclusion essay, I will sum it up all the main ideas like a formal interview.

SCRIPT/QUESTIONS - (*minimum 10 Questions and Answers*) (10 points)

1. Why do you think people do a sex change?
