*Dear students of Advanced Theatre for this assignment you will create a **15 to 20** minute play presentation about one of two Korean legends: The Haenyo women divers of Jeju-do or the great Admiral Yi Sun Shin. Please insure that you have a balanced share of lines and stage time and you are sharing work duties effectively. You will be required to create a poster, an original play based on research and in class discussions, and to perform in front of an audience. Here is the assignment rubric:*

PART A:

Research Outline - 25 points

Research outline (3-4 pages) You will be given a sheet which requires you to give a minimum of 5 resources you used to research your topic (must be separate from ones shared by the teacher in class) and explain how they helped you to fashion your story.

Play –Write-up - (10 being excellent)

Your play should be a minimum of 12 pages long and 20 pages maximum.
