Scene 1

Narrator: Long ago, there was a boy named Kosumi.

Kosumi: (waves) Hi~

Narrator: Although all of the Haida people around him showed respect to salmon and really thought they were a great part of society, Kosumi thought that salmon were just fish or food to eat when he was hungry. He treated salmon very disrespectfully and stepped on the bones when he was done eating them.

Salmon Boy: I don't care about salmon! (throws cut-out salmon on the floor and stomps on it)

Scene 2

Narrator: One day, Kosumi's mother made him salmon for lunch.

Mother: Kosumi, it's lunch time!

Salmon Boy: Huh? What time is it?

Mother: Oh, it's 12 PM, noon!

Salmon Boy: Oh, yay! What'd you make for me, Mom?

Mother: Your favorite... salmon!

(Gives plate to Salmon Boy)

(Salmon Boy glares at it)

Salmon Boy: Eww... This is moldy! I'm not going to eat this! (just throws paper plate and leaves)

Scene 3

(Everyone is playing outside)

(Salmon Boy comes back in as others play)

Salmon Boy: What are you guys doing?

Friend 1: We are playing with the water!

Friend 2: Yayyyy!~

Salmon Boy: Can I play with you?

Friend 2: Sure!!

Salmon Boy: Okay!!!

Friend 1: So, let's play hide and seek. I'll be the tagger. One, two, three...

(Salmon Boy and Friend 2 hide)

(Salmon Boy gets swept away in a "current")

Salmon Boy: Huh? Guys? Guys!!!

(Friend 1 and Friend 2 don't hear)

(Drowns)

(Salmon People enter)

Salmon Person 1: Hmm? Who's this?

Salmon Person 2: I don't know...He looks weird!

Salmon Person 1: Like an alien!

Salmon Person 2: Yeah!

Salmon Person 1: Let's try taking him to the other Salmon People!

Salmon Person 2: Yeah, maybe they'll put him in a museum or something!

(Salmon People enter and take him away)

Narrator: The boy felt a pull from his left leg and he thought that it was just a seaweed around his ankle, but he suddenly noticed that all of his friends were going away from him, or he was moving away from them.

(Salmon Boy wakes up and looks around as he gets pulled away)

Salmon Boy: Huh? What's happening? Why are they getting farther?

Narrator: He became aware of the fact that he was moving through the water.

Salmon Boy: Oh~ I'm moving through the water~

Narrator: As Kosumi made his trip to the Salmon People's town, he didn't realize that he was slowly turning into a salmon himself.

(Salmon Boy puts on Salmon costume)

Narrator: When he got to the Salmon People's town, he thought that all the salmon looked like people (even though they weren't).

Salmon Boy: Wow! Everyone here are people! This looks like my own home!

Salmon People: Now, we will teach you!

Salmon Boy: Wait... Who are you?

Salmon People: We are the Salmon People!!!

Salmon Boy: Wuhh???

Salmon People: We found you drowned at the bottom of the river, so we brought you here. So now we're going to educate you.

Salmon Boy: But I'm already educated!!

Salmon People: Just do it!

(Salmon Boy pretends to take notes)

Salmon Boy: Okay, I'm ready!

Salmon People: Okay, so first of all-

Salmon Boy: (stops taking notes and looks up and interrupts the person speaking) Wait! But I'm hungry!!!

Salmon People: Okay, fine. Then we'll start off teaching you how to get your food!!!

Narrator: The Salmon People taught Kosumi, or Salmon Boy, how to get his food and what to do with the remains.

Salmon People: Go to the stream and catch one of our children, and then eat it!

Salmon Boy: Okay!!! Byeeeeee (tries to leave)

Salmon People: Waitttttt!!!!

(Salmon Boy comes back)

Salmon People: You must be respectful and return everything you don't want to eat to the water.

Salmon Boy: Why?

Salmon People: The salmon will come back to life if you do that!

Salmon Boy: Oh, cool~

Salmon People: Be careful though, because if you do not return all of the bones to the water, the salmon child can't come back!

Salmon Boy: Oh, don't worry~

(Salmon Boy leaves)

Scene 4

Narrator: Salmon boy did as he was told for a long time.

(Salmon Boy fishes out the salmon and eats it all. Then he throws all the remains in to the ocean, except one)

Narrator: However, one day, Salmon Boy heard a child crying.

(Salmon child comes out and limps, saying "Ow" whenever he/she takes a step)

Salmon child: My foot is gone!

Salmon Boy: Why?

Salmon Child: Because *you* ate it and you didn't give it back!

Salmon Boy: Wait... But why do you need it? So I need to through EVERY part back into the river? The Salmon People didn't tell me that!

(Salmon Person pops in)

Salmon Person: Oh yeah, and by the way, if you don't throw one of the salmon's parts into the river, it will have that part missing when he or she is reborn.

Salmon Boy: (sarcastic) Wow, thanks!

(Salmon Person rushes out)

Salmon boy: Okay, sorry. So where is it?

Salmon Child: (points) Right THERE! Can't you see it?

Salmon Boy: Oh, THERE it is!!! (Throws fin back into stream)

(Salmon child is healed)

Salmon child: Yes! Finally! Thank you! (goes back into the water)

Scene 5

(All salmon are swimming around)

Narrator: The Salmon Boy spent the whole winter with the Salmon People, but when it was spring, they all had to return to the rivers again. However, one day, Salmon Boy was caught in his mother's net.

(Mother catches salmon boy)

Mother: Gotcha!

Salmon Boy: Ahh!!! No!!! Wait. Huh? Isn't that my mother?

(Salmon Boy gets pulled out of the water)

(Mother scans him)

Mother: Why do you seem familiar?

(Mother thinks)

Mother: Oh!!! Oh my. That copper necklace!! You're Kosumi??? Why are you in the shape of a salmon? Well, never mind about that. See, I told you having that copper necklace would do some good!

(Salmon Boy rolls his eyes)

(Mother takes Salmon boy back home)

Narrator: Salmon boy slowly shed his salmon skin. After 8 days, salmon boy was back in his human form again. Salmon boy taught the town all of the things he learned from the Salmon People. He soon became known as a healer because he knew more things than the other townspeople, and could cure illnesses as well. Of course, he learned all of these things from the Salmon people.

Salmon Boy: A few days after you take the medicine I give you, you will feel normal.

Town child 1: Wow, thanks! No wonder you're the healer! You know everything!

Salmon Boy: But I have something to confess. I cannot stay with you for long. It would be good for you to remember what I have taught you until now.

Townsboy 2: Why? Where are you going?

Narrator: He stayed together with the people until the time came. Salmon boy spotted a large salmon floating down toward him.
