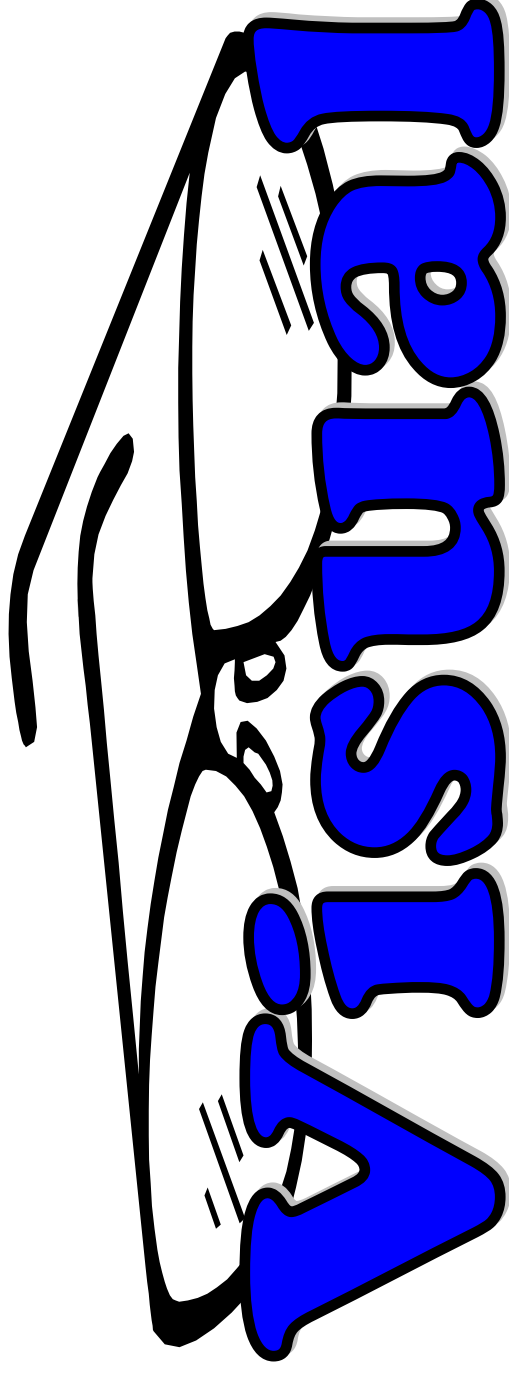




There are some words that we just need to remember.

We need to learn what these look like because there is no other way to spell them.

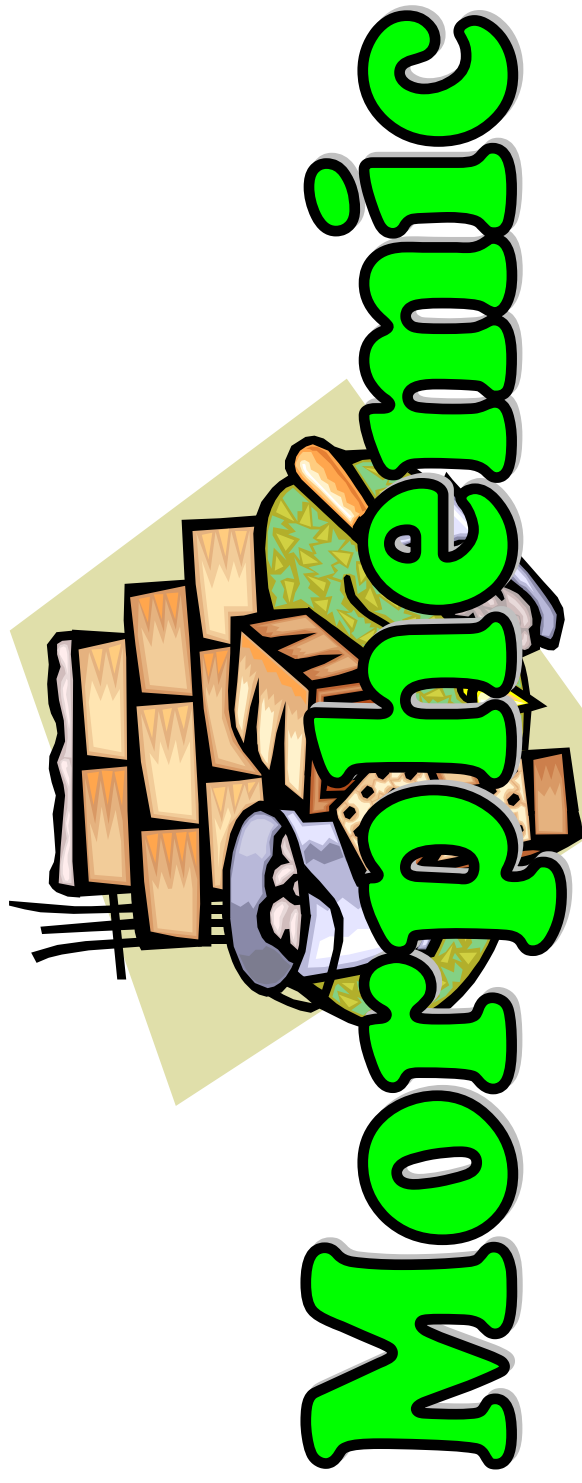
