<b>Organization</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Does not have an introduction and/or conclusion</li> <li>* Selects too much or too little information</li> <li>* Gets ideas mixed up</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Introduction and conclusion are not clear and/or interesting</li> <li>* Sometimes selects too much or too little information</li> <li>* Some ideas are connected but not all</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Introduction and conclusion are clear and interesting</li> <li>* Selects the right amount of information to present</li> <li>* States main idea and moves from one idea to the next clearly in an order that makes sense</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Introduction and conclusion are clear and memorable</li> <li>* Effectively presents appropriate information from a variety of sources</li> <li>* Main ideas are memorable and clearly connected to each other</li> </ul>
<b>Audio/Visual Aids</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Does not use aids, or if used, they are confusing</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Any used aids may distract from presentation</li> <li>* Aids are hard to read or hear (might be messy)</li> <li>* Aids are not well-incorporated into the presentation</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Aids add to the presentation</li> <li>* Aids are easy to see and/or hear (they are also neat)</li> <li>* Aids are used appropriately in the presentation</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Aids are especially creative and powerful</li> </ul>

<b>Vocal Delivery</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Mumbles or goes too fast or slowly</li> <li>* Speaks too softly to be heard</li> <li>* Frequently uses “filler” words</li> <li>* Pronounces several words incorrectly</li> <li>* Speaks with a style that is not appropriate for the occasion</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Speaks clearly some of the time, occasionally too fast or too slow</li> <li>* Speaks loudly enough for some audience members</li> <li>* Occasionally uses “filler” words</li> <li>* Pronounces a few words incorrectly</li> <li>* Speaks with an appropriate style most of the time</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Speaks clearly at an appropriate rate</li> <li>* Speaks loudly enough for everyone to hear</li> <li>* Rarely uses “filler” words</li> <li>* Pronounces words correctly</li> <li>* Speaks with appropriate style</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Adds variety to speaking style (lower or higher volume, change of pace or tone) to emphasize meaning</li> </ul>
<b>Physical Delivery</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Does not look at the audience, reads notes or slides</li> <li>* Holds things in hands nervously or keeps hands in pockets</li> <li>* Posture does not show confidence</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Makes some eye contact, but still reading notes most of the time</li> <li>* Uses a few gestures but still appears stiff or nervous</li> <li>* Posture shows some confidence, but may still fidget</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Keeps eye contact with audience most of the time</li> <li>* Uses hands naturally, making some gestures</li> <li>* Has confident posture</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Keeps eye contact all the time, does not read note or slides</li> <li>* Uses gestures smoothly to emphasize meaning</li> <li>* Moves with purpose</li> </ul>
