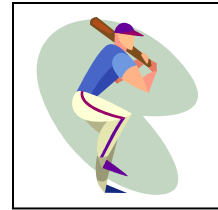


1. Peter had 20 baseball cards. He gave some to Mike and then he had 15 left. How many cards did Peter give to Mike?
