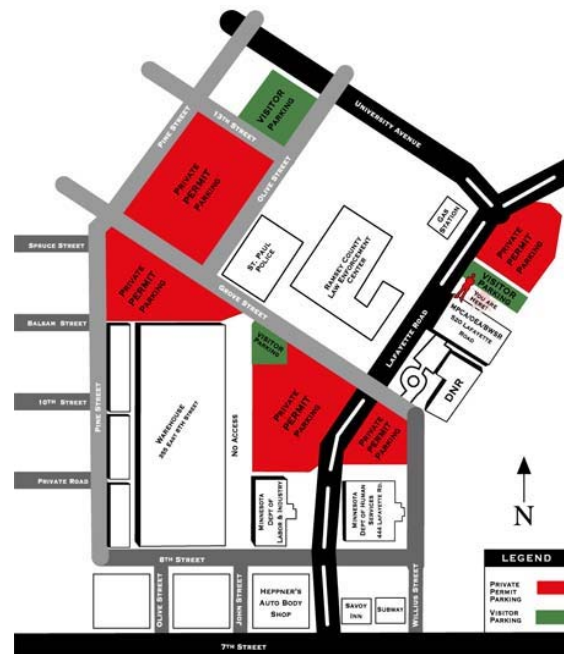

1:00 pm	Welcome, Introductions, Overview of the Meeting – Steve Pedersen, chair and Gretchen Sabel, facilitator
1:05	Work Group Reports: Education Work Group – Ron Struss will share results from the first meeting Manual Work Group – Judy Sventek will present recommendations and seek SSC concurrence Watershed Approach Work Group – covered in next agenda item Monitoring and Research Work Group – Bruce Wilson will give a 10 minute update on work being conducted at the U. Industrial Work Group – Erik Silvola will provide an update. Work of this group is getting underway, members are solicited. <i>Outcome – Committee provides guidance to the Work Groups.</i>
1:30	Watershed Approach Work Group: This work group has developed a revised framework. The document is being prepared by consultants, can be found on BWSR website at (link). Watershed group will meet May 11 to narrow alternatives to two or three. The watershed group will bring this recommendation to the SSC and seek concurrence. The alternatives selected will then be fleshed out over the coming year with continued funding from US EPA. Doug Thomas from BWSR will present the work group's recommendations, and seek SSC concurrence. He will also be able to discuss the current Request for Proposals for that work (link) at the meeting. <i>Outcome – SSC will discuss work group recommendations, and alternatives will be agreed to by SSC or another course of action recommended.</i>

2:45	Stormwater Pollution Prevention Acceleration at the MPCA Work is now underway to bring more staff resources into this work area. Gary Pulford and Anne Gelbmann will be on hand to present current thinking and solicit input. <i>Outcome – Ideas on this topic will be presented, SSC input sought. Workplan and staffing decisions for FY07 to be made by MPCA in the next month based on outcomes of this meeting.</i>
3:30	Possible Changes in MPCA Enforcement Authority and MPCA Fees for Stormwater: Brian Livingston will solicit feedback on the concept of possible enforcement authority changes for construction stormwater sites to provide a consistent and level playing field for the industry. Gretchen Sabel will present MPCA budget issues and request SSC input through a separate process over the course of the summer. <i>Outcome – A process for SSC input on these issues will be developed and put into action.</i>
