

## LEGISLATURE AND GOVERNANCE

Policies mainly remain but need better state implementation to achieve our goals more effectively:

- Better use Department of Monitoring and Evaluation and Treasury, plus COGTA, DPSA and the School of Governance to drive state
- Improve intergovernmental planning, coordination, land use planning
- Back to Basics remains programme to strengthen local government. Weaknesses in local government capacity must be addressed and responsibilities of weak municipalities must be restricted to performing their core mandate.
- Review two tiers of local and district municipalities urgently
- Deploy cadres to the state based on merit, recruit public service managers with professional and technical capacity, and strengthen the School of Governance to build values and capacity
- Improve SOEs regulation on roles and mandate, SOE oversight by parliament, Clarify role in achieving NDP. Deploy competent and professional managers, board members and root out corruption.

# PROPOSALS



- Improve anti-corruption mechanisms and laws, make reporting corruption compulsory in government. Do lifestyle audits on senior public servants
- Set up an ANC Electoral Commission to set selection criteria and processes, and screen ANC public representatives.
- Monitor performance of all public representatives.
- Permanent and professional capacity to win elections and by-elections, supported by research and info management system
- Develop a clear approach to coalitions in government and to ANC role where we are in opposition
- Hold a consultative conference around issues of concern in traditional areas and develop government policy to regularise powers of traditional leaders.
