

Math Final Advice

Preparation.

- Spread out your studying.
- Do some physical activity immediately before and/or after study sessions.
- Use old quizzes and exams to study.
- Ask for help with concepts that you cannot seem to grasp from studying.
- Ask for help if you do not understand how to use your graphing calculator.

Just Before the Final Exam.

- Do *not* wait until just before the exam to ask questions.
- Bring all required materials (pencil, calculator, etc.).
- Bring an extra set of batteries (four AAA).
- Get plenty of sleep.
- Bring water. (No other beverages are allowed in the exam room.)
- Eat something. (No food is allowed in the exam room.)
- Use the restroom.
- Do *not* consume caffeinated beverages or energy drinks.
- Come early to the exam room.
- Relax.

During the Final Exam.

- Read directions carefully and follow them.
- Do problems that you are certain you can do correctly first.
- Show all work. If you are using a calculator to do a problem, explain briefly what you did to arrive at your answer.
- Pay attention to unit standard labels.
- When in doubt, write out everything you know that pertains to a problem.
