Complete questions on this exam according to the following instructions:

- Answer at least twelve questions overall.
- Address at least two standards from each unit.
- Answer at least one question that involves standard C3 (writing).
- Answer at least one question that involves standard 1B (units).
- Answer at least one question that involves standard 2D (solving systems of equations with algebra).
- Answer at least one question that involves standard 4A (linear functions).
- Answer at least one question that involves standard 4E (modeling).

Failure to follow the instructions given above will result in a maximum grade of C on this exam.

On this document, circle the problem number of all problems that you want graded. You must select at least twelve problems; you may do more problems and select more than twelve problems to have graded. Write all solutions on extra paper. Turn in all work along with this document.

For all problems, show all work. Do not round unless the answer involves money or you are instructed to round. You may use a graphing calculator for all problems on the final exam except for the one on the last page.
