



Make A Calendar

Learning Standards:
(1.1 The standard typed out)

Student Objectives:
Students will count, read and write numbers to 30

Procedures:

1. Draw an empty number line on the board. Write 0 on the left side of the line.
 2. Elicit information that 1 is more than 0 and 2 is more than 1, and so on, as you continue to fill in the numbers on the line. For example, as "What number is one more than three?"
 3. Use this calendar to play the "Place the Number on the Calendar" game with children
 4. "Place the Number on the Calendar" - create number cards with the numbers 1 to 31 and place them on the calendar so that children can see where the month begins and ends.
 5. Give the rest of the number cards to the children. Call on the children to come to the front of the room and place their number card where it belongs. Encourage them to count from the number one until they reach their number to find out where their card belongs.
1. Open template in Pixie titled "Make A Calendar"
 2. Students will use a separate text box to type in numbers in the calendar for this month.
 3. Use a separate text box to type the month on the top.
