Procedures:
Paint Pictures for Your Book

1. Go to a computer.
2. Create a folder on your Desktop and name it Math Project.
3. Open Pixie.
4. Use the paint tools and stickers to draw pictures for academic vocabulary.
5. Use the Text tool to add a text box.
6. Click the page background. Click the Record button in the options panel to record narration.
7. Click the Save button on the toolbar. Make sure you save to the Math folder.
8. Go to the File menu and choose New.
9. Repeat steps 4-8 until you have drawn all the pictures from your storyboard.

Create an Slide Show Book

1. Go to a computer.
2. Open Pixie.
3. Click the Share button on the toolbar. Click the Slide in the Options panel.
4. Click the Start button.
5. Slide show will automatically start
