Summer School Regulations

- Students must leave the building after their last summer course.
- Loitering on school grounds is **NOT** permitted.
- Use of tobacco products is **Not** permitted on school grounds.
- Food/drink/parking in designated areas only.
- Students are expected to be in class when the period begins. Lateness is excess of 15 minutes will be considered an absence. Lateness less than 15 minutes will be considered one-half absence.
- Students who have more than three class absences will not receive course credit.

1. Summer Session

A. Summer School is in session from Wednesday, July 6, 2011 through Tuesday, August 16, 2011.

B. Wednesday, August 17, 2011 is the last day of instruction and local exams.

2. Attendance

The brief duration of summer school makes regular attendance imperative. Parents will be notified when a student is absent. Students are expected to attend class and participate in each day during the session. Family vacations are not legitimate reasons for absenteeism.

3. All students must be residents of the Ramapo Central School District.

4. Transportation is the students' responsibility.

A student with 31 or more absences in a full- year course, or 16 or more absences in a semester course, may not take that course in Summer School unless approved by the Principal.
