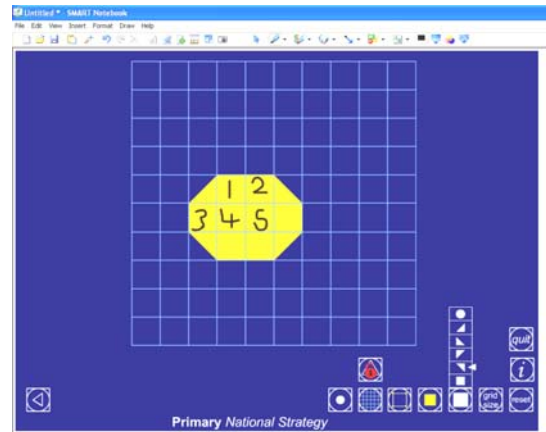


Technical Advice for Viewing ITPs within Smart Notebook

If you use an interactive whiteboard to view the Interactive Teaching Programs you may find it necessary to annotate over the ITP. On a Smart Board, as soon as you touch the screen, the annotations are lost.

An important new development enables Smart Board users to use the Interactive Teaching Programs within Smart Notebook. You can alternate between working with the ITP and annotating the notebook.

Please note that if you save the Smart Notebook file, the annotations will be saved but the ITP will have reverted back to its opening screen when you next open it.



In order to have access to this facility, you need to download the latest version of the Smart board software, version 9.1.3 or above.

This will not work with the ITPs that you currently have. You need to download Shockwave flash versions. These can be saved in your Smart Notebook gallery as a 'collection file'.

The ITP collection file is available from the ICT section of the Lancashire Primary Mathematics website.

To load the ITP collection file:

- Open Smart Notebook.
- Click on the 'Gallery' tab on the right hand side of the screen.
- Click on the 'Add/Import' button.
- Click on 'Import Collection File' and locate it on your computer
- Open the file and it will copy over.

To open an ITP in Smart Notebook:

- Click on the 'Gallery' tab down the right hand side of the Notebook.
- Double click the icon in 'Gallery' and it appears on the screen.
- Select and resize the ITP as required.
