Dear Ms. Lopez:

Utica Community Schools is in receipt of your Good Faith deposit for your Freedom of Information Request dated April 13. Your request is granted in part and denied in part.

Enclosed are 2008-2009 documents in response to your request for:

- Records of salaries more than \$150k and Benefits information in dollars.
- Records of salaries for Board of Education Members
 - Superintendent of Schools
 - Local Superintendents, chief education officers or chief executive officers
- District cell phone use
- District personal car use

Per Section 18 (2) of the Michigan Public Act 94 of 1979, The State School Aid Act, the salary information for 2010 can be found under the Transparency Reporting section at our district web-site www.uticak12.org.

I hereby certify the district has no record for *overtime hours for retiring personnel from January 1, 2008 to January 1, 2011*.

Your request is also denied only insofar as some of these documents may contain personally identifiable information, which by law is not disclosable and such information has been redacted from the files.

15.243 Exemptions from disclosure; public body as school district or public school academy; withholding of information required by law or in possession of executive office.

Sec. 13.(1) A public body may exempt from disclosure as a public record under this act:


- (a) Information of a personal nature where the public disclosure of the information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of an individual's privacy.

In so far as your request for this information on a spreadsheet, please be advised Per Section 3 (4) of the Act, it is not required of a public body to make a compilation, summary, or report of information.

You may appeal this decision by submitting to the District's Superintendent a written appeal that states the word "appeal" and identifies the reason or reasons for reversal of the denial. Alternatively, you may appeal this decision by filing a civil action in circuit court. The prevailing party in a circuit court action may be awarded reasonable attorneys' fees, costs and disbursements and, if the court determines the District's denial was arbitrary or capricious, actual or compensatory damages and punitive damages in the amount of \$500.00.

The balance due is reflected on the enclosed invoice. Please make check payable to Utica Community Schools.
