Request For Proposals No. 016-JJ10 – STATE LEGISLATIVE CONSULTANT, is to provide state legislative consulting services for The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida. This is a term proposal. Six (6) proposers responded to this advertised solicitation.

For the past three years, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, has had a contract for state legislative consulting services with the firm of Ronald L. Book, P.A. & Associates, and Florida School Services, Inc., awarded through the Request For Proposals process at the Board's December 14, 2005, regularly scheduled School Board meeting. The contracts will expire on December 31, 2008, and no additional extension periods are available. Therefore, to ensure continued legislative support during the upcoming 2009 state legislative session, a Request For Proposals No. 016-JJ10 was issued by Procurement Management, for state legislative consulting services.

Miami-Dade County Public Schools continues to face many critical legislative issues, including declining revenues. It is anticipated that the 2009 legislative session will be as challenging as in recent years, with education and other interests competing for limited state resources. Therefore, the work of a legislative lobbying team will continue to be of critical importance.

The Selection Committee met to evaluate proposals received in response to the Request For Proposals on December 1, 2008, to consider the six proposals received: Akerman Senterfitt; Becker & Poliakoff, P.A.; Ronald L. Book, P.A.; Florida School Services, Inc.; Floridian Partners, LLC; and Shutts & Bowen LLP. After considerable discussion, based on the submitted documents, the Committee unanimously recommended the following firms to provide legislative consulting services for the period January 1, 2009, through December 31, 2009: Akerman Senterfitt; Becker & Poliakoff, P.A.; Florida School Services, Inc., and Ronald L. Book, P.A.

The consultants will work under the day-to-day direction of Ms. Iraida R. Mendez-Cartaya, Assistant Superintendent, Office of Intergovernmental Affairs, Grants Administration, and Community Services. The cost of the state legislative consulting services shall not exceed \$294,000, inclusive of all fees and expenses, including travel, to be paid in equal monthly installments commencing January 2009. This amount represents approximately 20% reduction of the current contracts for these services.

The contracts may be extended for up to three (3) additional annual terms with the same or modified terms, as mutually agreed upon, after review of the services provided are deemed to be satisfactory.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, **AUTHORIZE** the Superintendent to approve the negotiation of contracts for state legislative consulting services, contingent upon exhaustion of the statutory requirements of F.S. 120.57 with the following firms, in an amount not to exceed \$294,000, pursuant to Request For Proposals No. 016-JJ10 – STATE LEGISLATIVE CONSULTANT, effective January 1, 2009, through December 31, 2009, as follows:

SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND ALCALDE & FAY, PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 097-DD10 – FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE CONSULTANT

COMMITTEE: BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL SERVICES

Request For Proposals No. 097-DD10 – Federal Legislative Consultant, opened on June 24, 2004, to provide legislative services to assist in advocating the School Board's interest before the South Florida Congressional Delegation, federal legislative committees, and the Executive Branch, including the Secretaries of Education, Commerce, Health and Human Services, and Justice, as well as pertinent regulatory agencies, for the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs and Grants Administration. This is a term proposal. Of 34 proposers sent proposal forms or card notices of this advertised proposal, 9 responded.

A meeting of the selection committee to evaluate proposals received in response to the Request For Proposals was held on October 13, 2004. Nine proposals were presented for consideration, The Advocacy Group; Alcalde & Fay; Greenberg Traurig; Dickstein Shapiro Morin & Oshinsky LLP; Holland & Knight LLP; Jefferson Government Relations, LLC; Smith Dawson & Andrews; Tew Cardenas LLP; and Venable LLP. After significant discussion, a motion was passed to recommend that three firms be invited to participate in oral presentations. On October 29, 2004, a second meeting composed of the selection committee was called to hear presentations from the three firms. On November 29, 2004, the committee met to conduct final deliberations. Based on the proposals submitted and the oral presentations, the committee chose to recommend Alcalde & Fay as the consultant for the District.
