Mile Swim - 5:30 AM (See Schedule), Waterfront A

Rise and Shine with this early morning test of perseverance. You must attend all practices on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday in order to participate in the Mile Swim on Thursday. *Bring your buddy tag!*

Free Swim - Twilight Monday & Tuesday, Waterfront A
