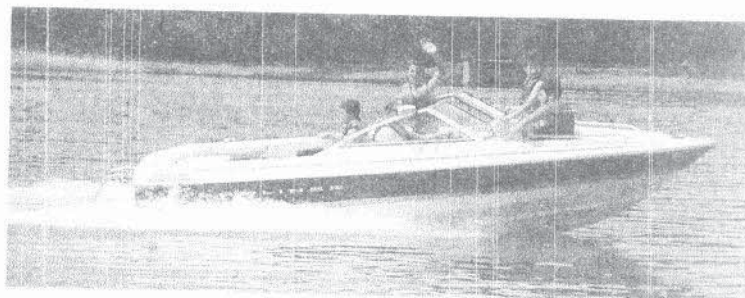
PART OF THE CAMP RAINEY MOUNTAIN PROGRAM THE AQUATICS BIG WET PACKAGE!

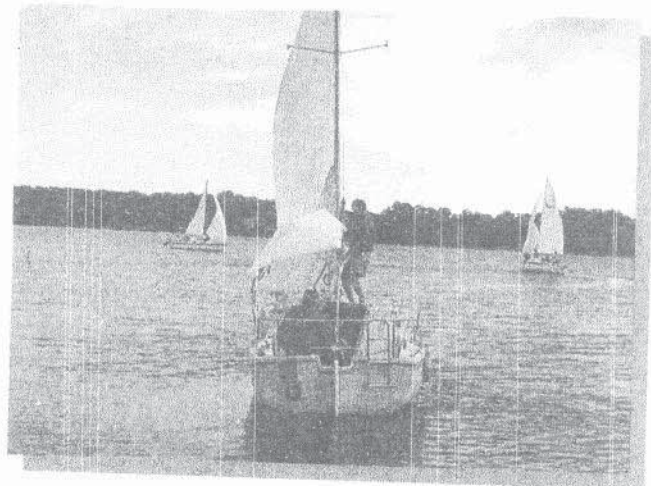

Join us at Scoutland Aquatics Outpost for a sailing

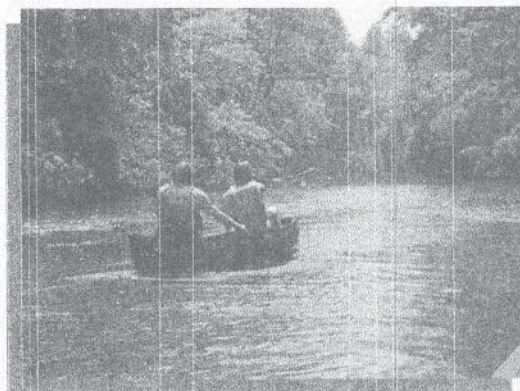
adventure! Live aboard your own 22' sail boat while "learning the ropes." Develop teamwork and leadership skills in this dynamic environment of sailing. Scouts will learn knots, marlinespike, anchoring and ground tackle, points of sailing, rules of the road, navigation, piloting, and sail trimming. This course is ideal for beginning sailors.



Whitewater Canoe

You will learn how to maneuver and paddle your canoe on some of Northeast Georgia's most exciting whitewater for beginners. Learn basic whitewater techniques and

handling, rescue methods, and much more!

- ☐ Whitewater Canoe will stay in tents on platforms and each participant will sleep on a cot.

Each participant must have a completed medical form #34605 signed by a doctor.

Cost: \$75(non-refundable) registration fee required to reserve a spot. Remainder of fee is due by June 1st, 2009. Total cost to attend is \$265.00, which includes t-shirt and patch with the successful completion of the program. Space is extremely limited and registrations should be received by **April 15th, 2010.**
