rhymes

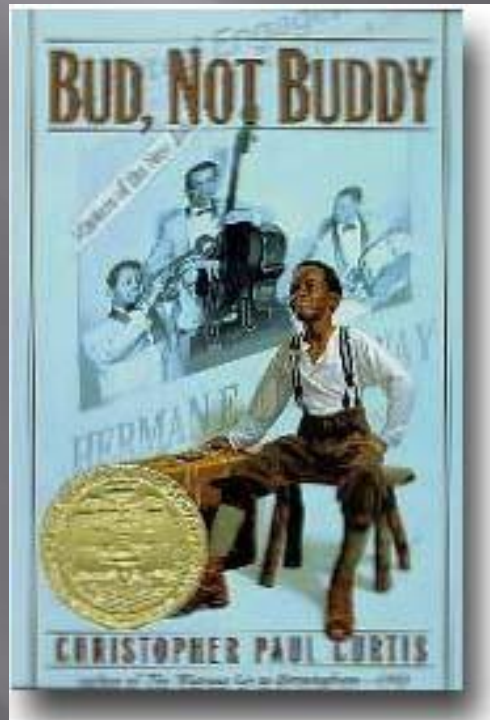
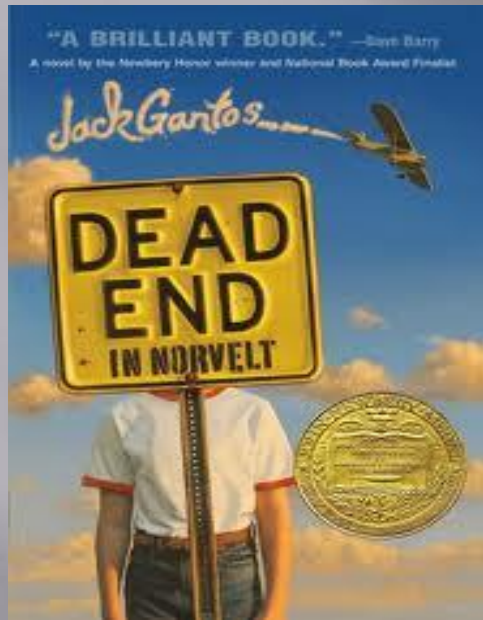
- was an insperation for
