



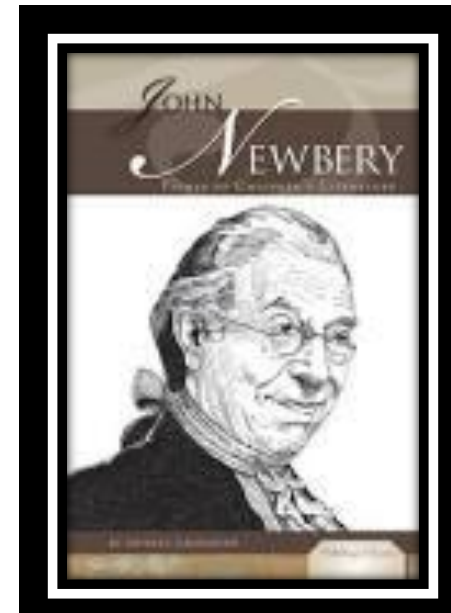

- Loved reading and soon had a wide knowledge of literature.

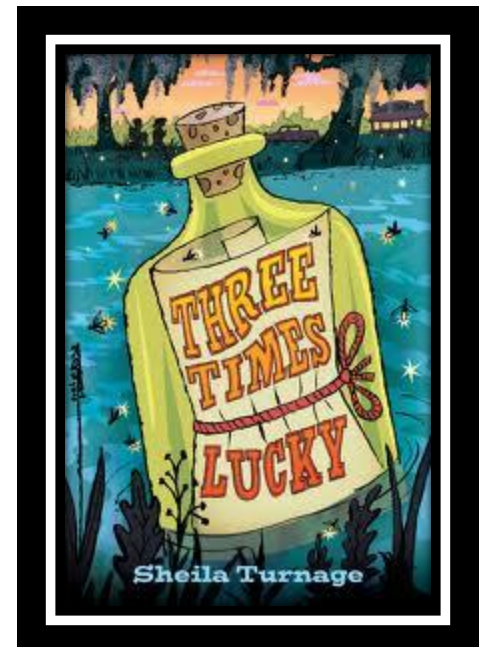
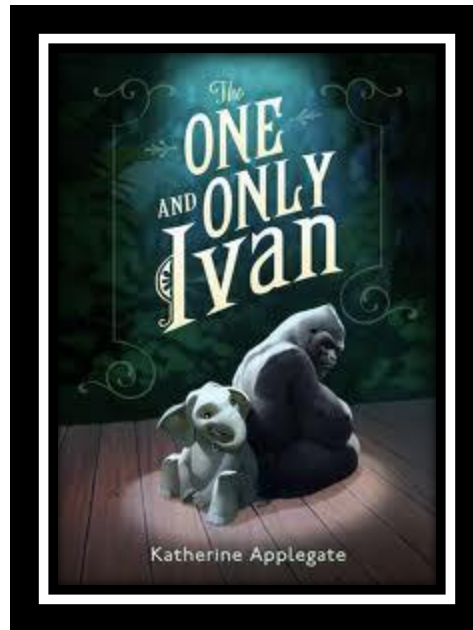
