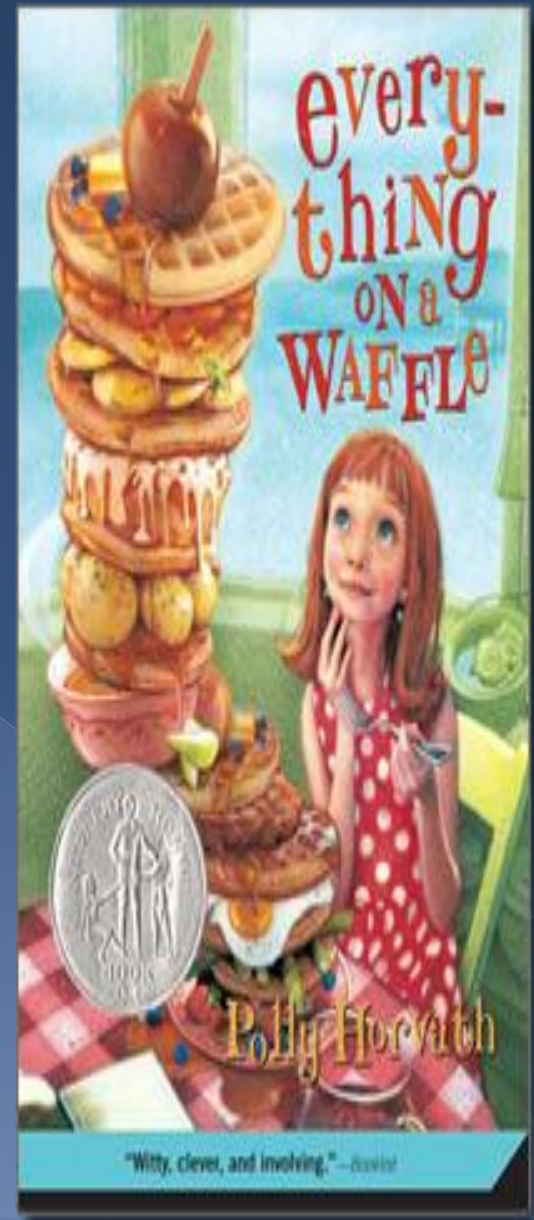
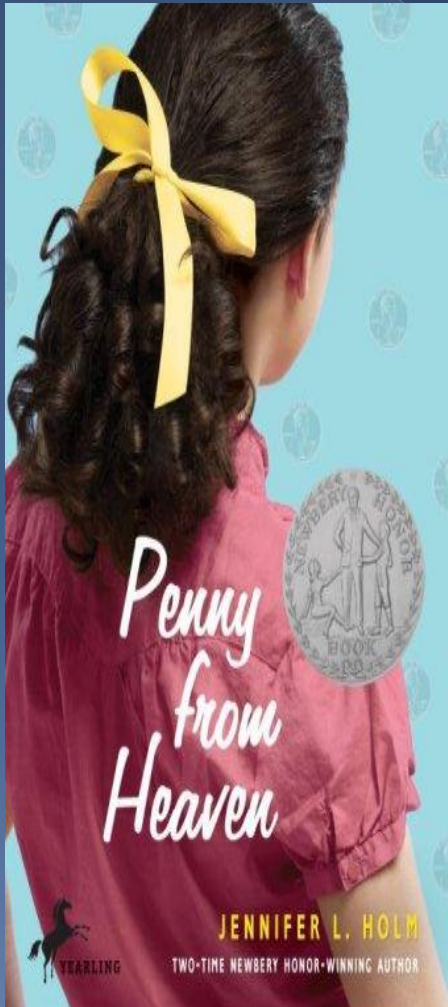
# Why is the award named after John Newbery?
