# John Newbery

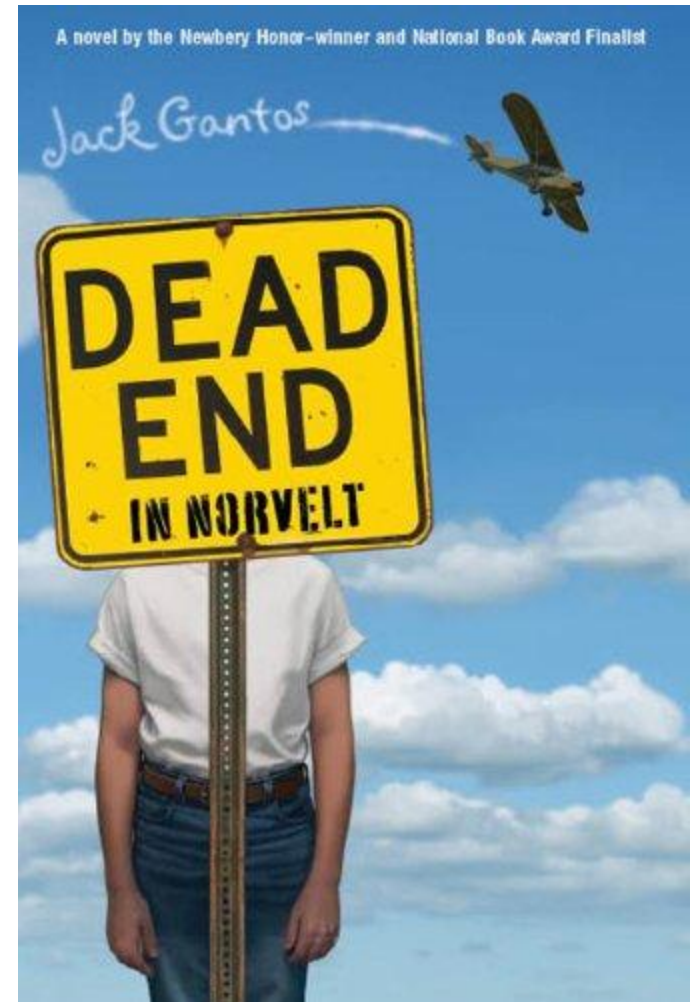
- Born in Waltham St. Lawrence, England, in 1713.
- As a child he loved reading and writing.
- In 1730, Newbery found a job as an assistant to William Carnan, the editor of the newspaper The Reading Mercury.
- Then, in 1744, he set up a shop in London, The Bible and Sun, where he sold medicine and books

- The Newbery Award is given by the American Library Association.
- They give it to the most distinguished contribution to children's literature within the U.S.
