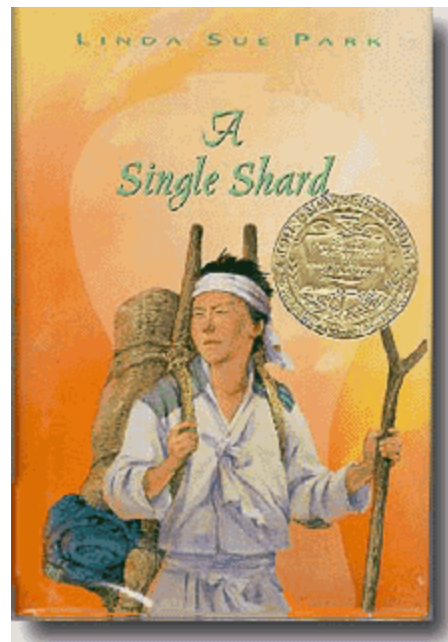
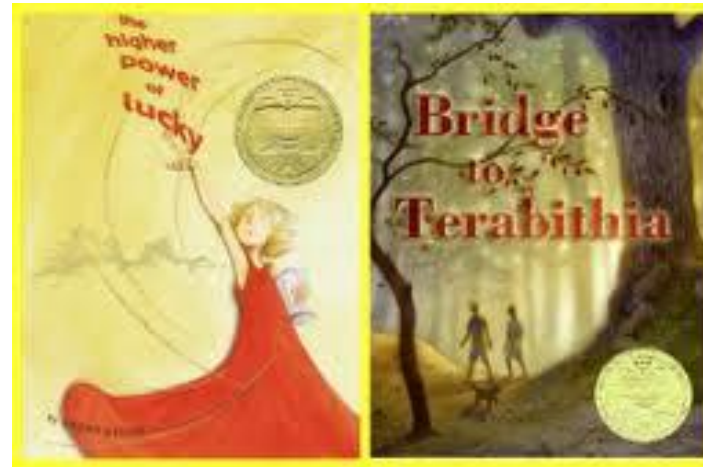
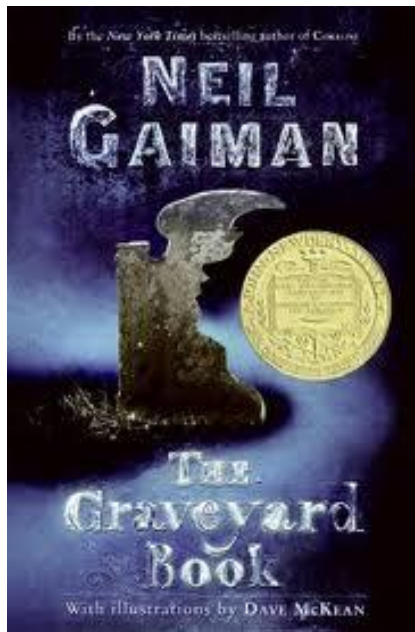
## WHY IS THE NEWBERY AWARD NAMED AFTER JOHN NEWBERY?
