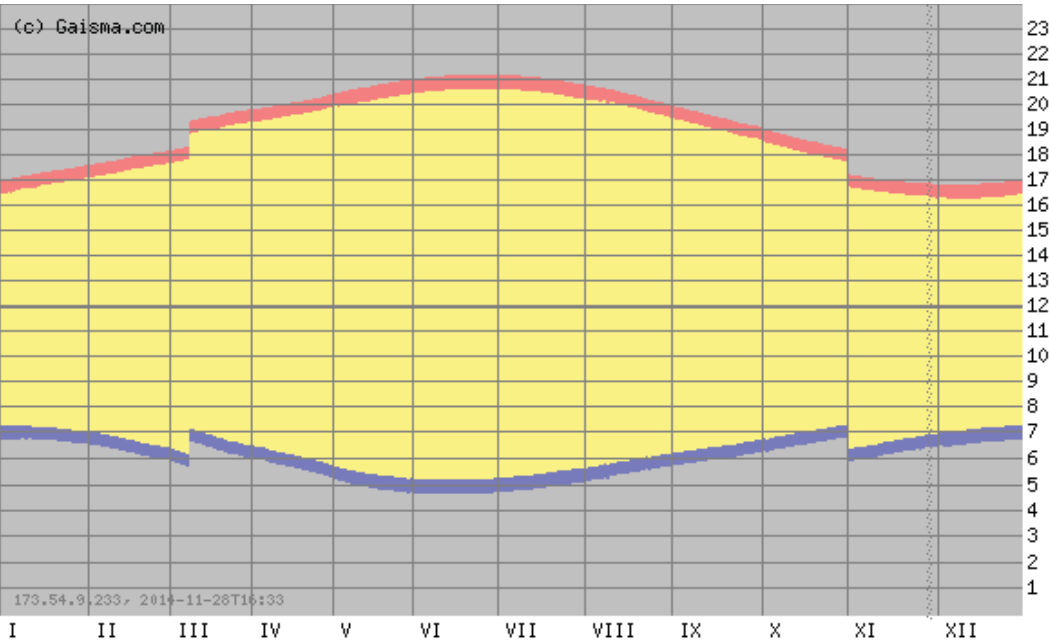
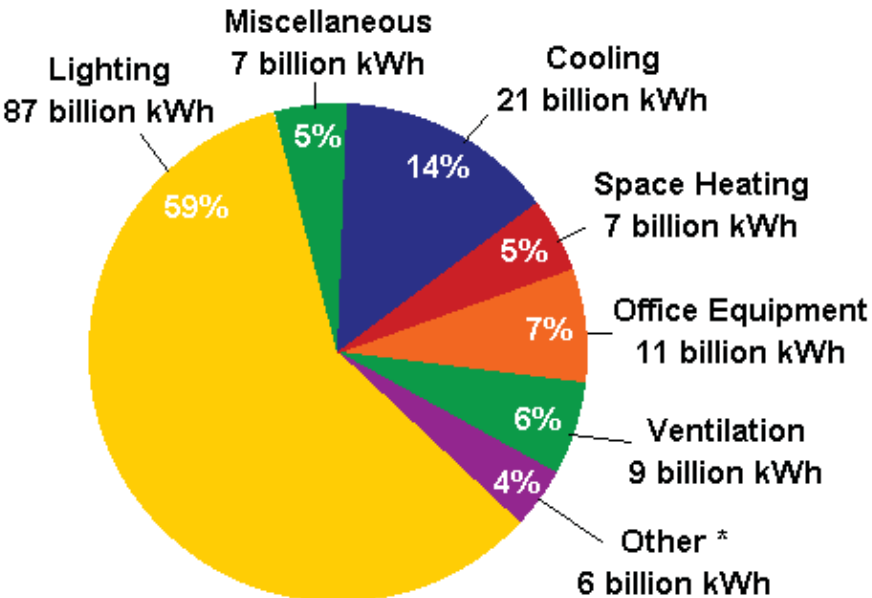
Time use on an average work day for employed persons ages 25 to 54 with children

Common 60W Incandescent Bulb

uses 60W per bulb for 800 lumens

1 bulb lasts 1,200 hrs

20 years = 21 bulbs



Common 14W CFL Bulb

uses 14W per bulb for 800 lumens

1 bulb lasts 10,000 hrs

20 years = 3 CFL bulbs



Philips 12.5W AmbientLED Bulb

uses 12.5W per bulb for 800 lumens

1 bulb lasts 25,000 hrs

20 years = 1 LED bulb
