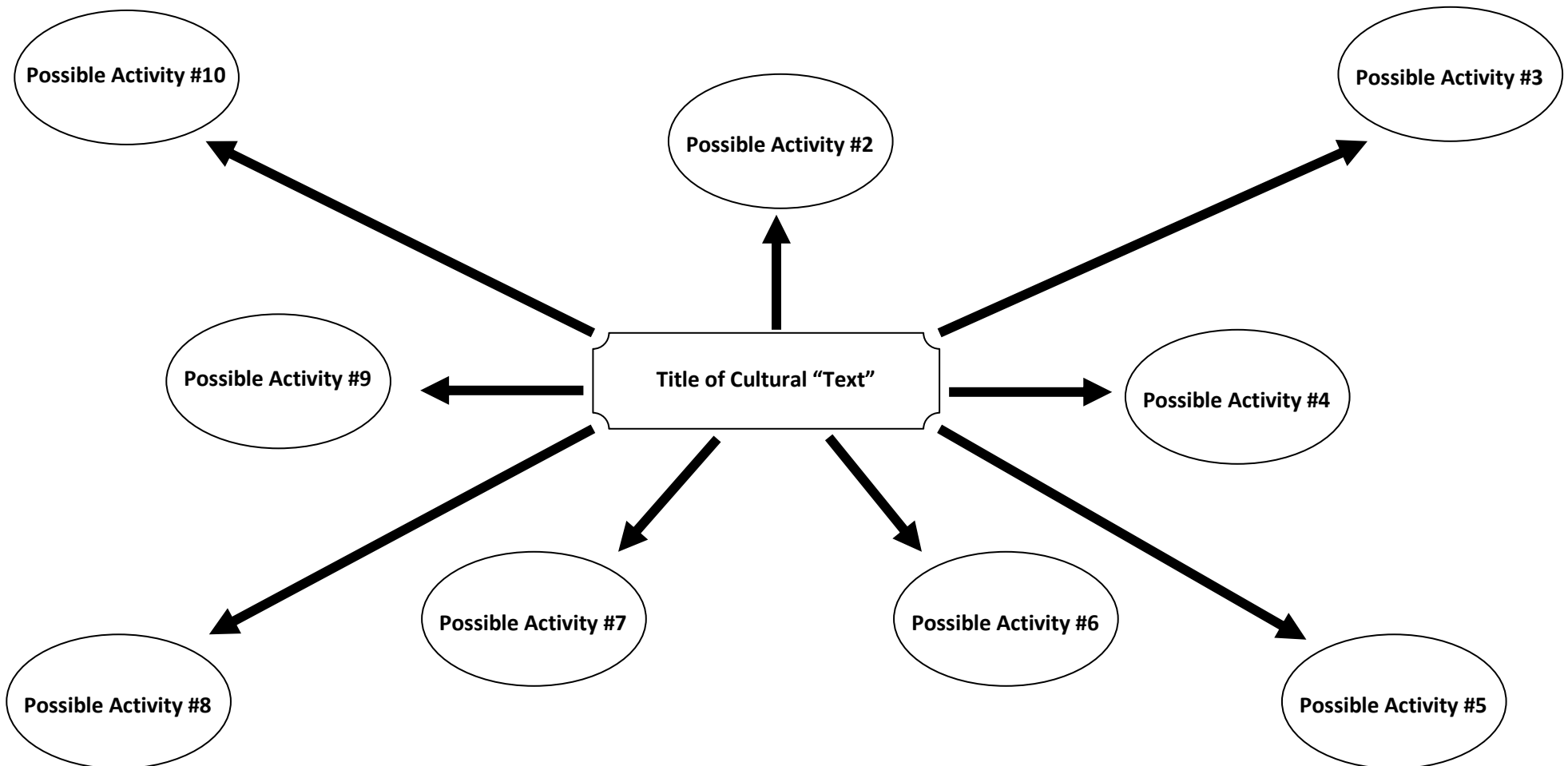


## Cultural “Text” Brainstorming Web

- [Mindomo](#) (Beautiful interface, not quite as intuitive as some of the others, but can handle attachments of multimedia, documents, etc., and produces a more professional product)
