

A Beginner's Guide to Vistaprint

1) When you first go to vistaprint.com, you will be able to order some things for free. It may seem at first that this is limited, but after you place your first order or two, they will send you TONS of emails with more free items you can purchase.

2) You can order 10 free items at a time. Once you have 10 items in your cart, you can check out and all you'll pay for is shipping. (This may have changed actually – you may be able to get more than 10 at a time. Just make sure to watch the prices in your shopping cart to make sure they stay at FREE.)

3) All of your stuff is saved in a portfolio, so if you need more later, you can simply use one of the emails with the free stuff, click on that free item you need to reorder, click on your portfolio and that particular item and it will go in your cart for free!

4) If you get an email with free shipping with an order of \$30, you can order your \$30 worth of paid stuff, then 10 free items and only pay \$30! It's one of the best Vistaprint options!

5) You can usually only order one of each type of free item per order. For example if you want to make postcards to welcome kids to your class AND postcards for conference reminders, you will have to do those in two separate orders.
