- As he talks to you you try to draw what he is saying so you will have a visual image to remind you of where he is staying.

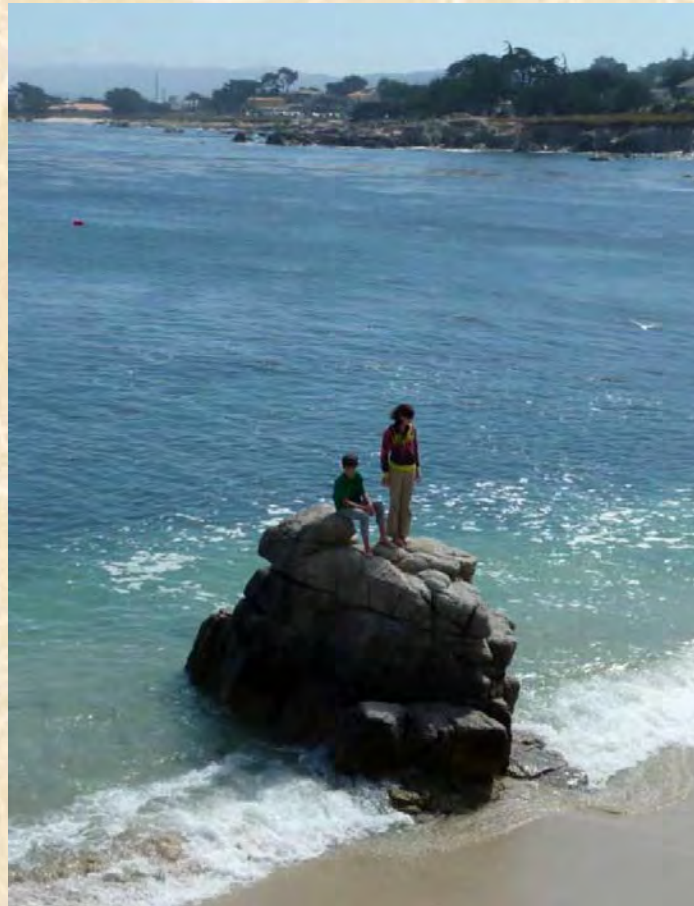

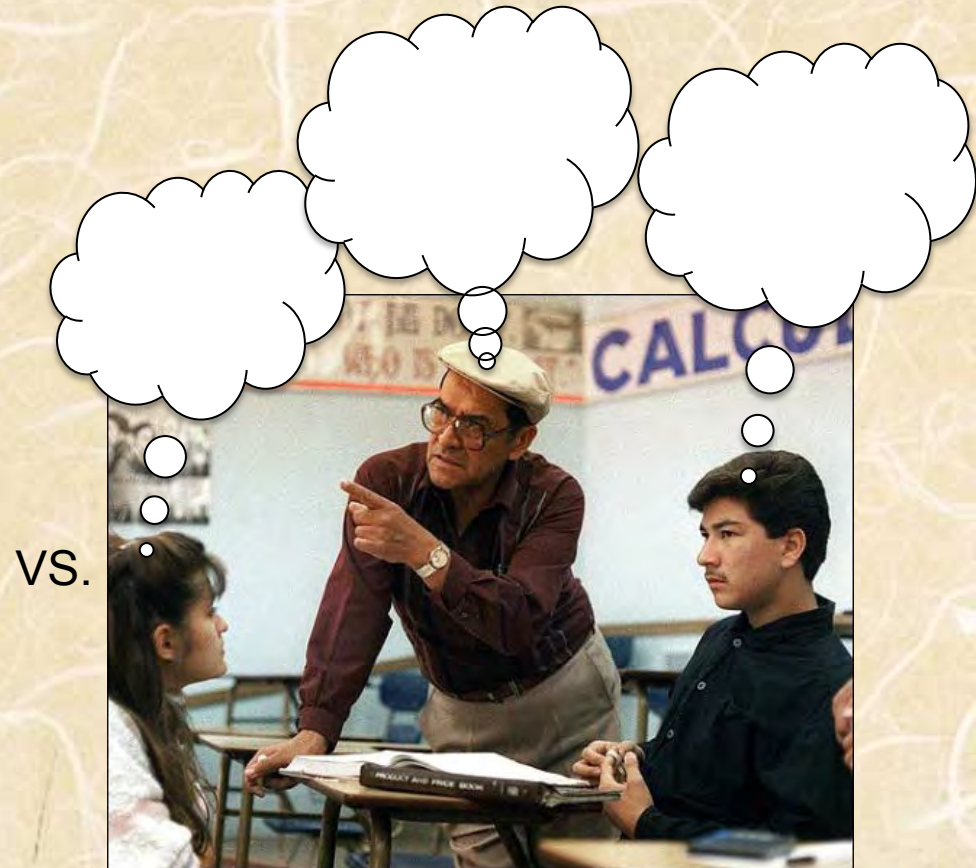

- **Role as a writer:** Who are you as a writer?
- **Audience:** To whom are you writing?
- **Format:** In what format are you writing?
- **Topic:** What are you writing about?

Franco	People of Spain	Letter	Protest his innocence
Museum curator	Picasso	Newspaper interview	Questions about the painting
