



Google Chrome keyboard Shortcuts

Tab and window shortcuts

Ctrl+N Ctrl+T Ctrl+Shift+N Ctrl+O then select file.	Opens a new window. Opens a new tab. Opens a new window in incognito mode. Opens a file from your computer in Google Chrome.
Ctrl + click a link or click a link with mousewheel	Opens the link in a new tab in the background.
Ctrl+Shift + click a link or press Shift and click a link with mousewheel.	Opens the link in a new tab and switches to the newly opened tab.
Shift + click a link.	Opens the link in a new window.
Ctrl+Shift+T	Reopens the last tab you've closed (up to 10 last closed tabs).
Drag a link to a tab. Drag a link to a blank area on the tab strip. Drag a tab out of the tab strip.	Opens the link in the tab. Opens the link in a new tab.
Drag a tab out of the tab strip and into an existing window.	Opens the tab in a new window.
Ctrl+1 through Ctrl+8	Opens the tab in the existing window.
Alt+F4 Ctrl+W or Ctrl+F4	Switches to the tab at the specified position number on the tab strip. Closes the current window. Closes the current tab or pop-up.
Click tab with mousewheel.	Closes the tab you clicked.
Backspace (or Alt + Left)	Goes to the previous page in your browsing history for the tab.
Shift+Backspace or Alt + Right	Goes to the next page in your browsing history for the tab.
Click Forward/Backward button with mousewheel.	Opens the button destination in a new tab in the background.
Double click the blank area on the tab strip.	Maximizes or minimizes the window.
Alt+Home	Opens homepage in current window.

Text shortcuts

Ctrl+C Ctrl+V or Shift+Insert Ctrl+Shift+V	Copies highlighted text to the clipboard. Pastes content from the clipboard. Paste content from the clipboard without formatting.
Ctrl+X or Shift+Delete	Deletes the highlighted content and copies it to the clipboard.

Google Chrome feature shortcuts

Alt+F or Alt+E	Opens the wrench menu, which lets you customize and control settings in Google Chrome.
Ctrl+Shift+B	Toggles the bookmarks bar on and off.
Ctrl+H	Opens the History page.
Ctrl+J	Opens the Downloads page.
Shift+Esc	Opens the Task Manager.
Ctrl+Shift+Delete	Opens the Clear Browsing Data dialog.

Address bar shortcuts

Type a search term, then press Enter .	Performs a search using your default search engine.
Type a search engine keyword, press Space , type a search term, and press Enter .	Performs a search using the search engine associated with the keyword.
Begin typing a search engine URL, press Tab when prompted, type a search term, and press Enter .	Performs a search using the search engine associated with the URL.
Ctrl+Enter	Adds www. and .com to your input in the address bar and open the resulting URL.
Type a URL, then press Alt+Enter .	Opens the URL in a new tab.
Ctrl+L or Alt+D Ctrl+K or Ctrl+E	Highlights the URL. Places a '?' in the address bar. Type a search term after the question mark to perform a search using your default search engine.
Ctrl and the left arrow together.	Moves your cursor to the preceding key term in the address bar
Ctrl and the right arrow together.	Moves your cursor to the next key term in the address bar
Ctrl+Backspace	Deletes the key term that precedes your cursor in the address bar Deletes the entry from your browsing history, if possible.
Select an entry in the address bar drop-down menu with your keyboard arrows, then press Shift+Delete .	
Click an entry in the address bar drop-down menu with your middle mouse button (or mousewheel).	Opens the entry in a new tab in the background.
Press Page Up or Page Down when the address bar drop-down menu is visible.	Selects the first or last entry in the drop-down menu.

Webpage shortcuts

Ctrl+P Ctrl+S F5 or Ctrl+R Esc Ctrl+F	Prints your current page. Saves your current page. Reloads your current page. Stops the loading of your current page. Opens the find bar.
Click the middle mouse button (or mousewheel).	Activates auto-scrolling. As you move your mouse, the page automatically scrolls according to the direction of the mouse.
Ctrl+F5 or Shift+F5	Reloads your current page, ignoring cached content.
Press Alt and click a link. Ctrl+U Drag a link to bookmarks bar Ctrl+D Ctrl+Shift+D	Downloads the target of the link. Opens the source of your current page. Saves the link as a bookmark. Saves your current webpage as a bookmark. Saves all open pages as bookmarks in a new folder.
F11	Opens your page in full-screen mode. Press F11 again to exit full-screen.
Ctrl and scroll your mousewheel.	Enlarges or makes the text font smaller
Ctrl+0	Returns everything on the page to normal size.
Space bar Home End	Scrolls down the web page. Goes to the top of the page. Goes to the bottom of the page.


