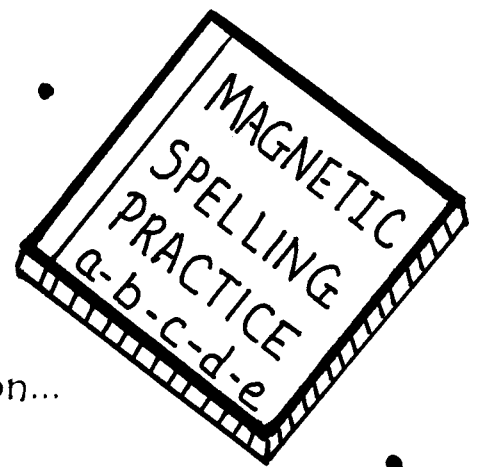


# Magnetic CD Cases



## Materials needed...

- \*Empty CD cases
- \*1/2 in. magnetic strip
- \*Magnetic sheets
- \*Magnetic metal 4 3/4 in. square
- \*Paper
- \*Scissors

- (H) Historic timeline
- (S) Science vocabulary words
- (L) Building descriptive sentences
- (R) CD case book report
- (M) Review of basic facts
- (W) Magnetic letters for spelling

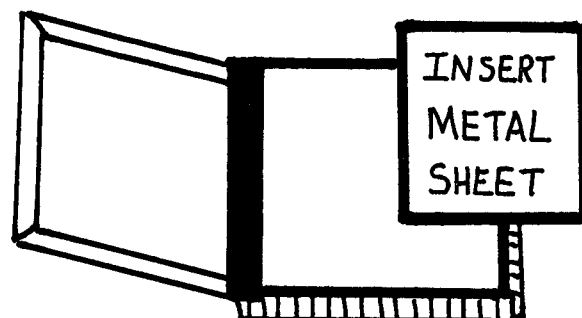
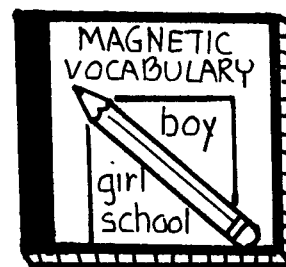
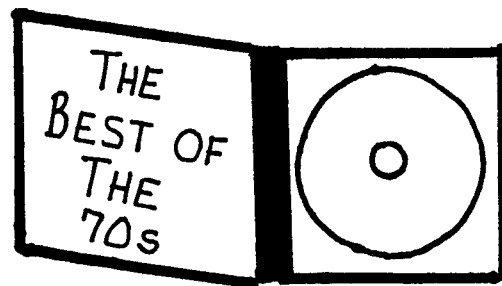
## Instructions...

(1) Carefully remove any cardboard, plastic, or tag-board from the inside of the CD case. (See blacklines.)

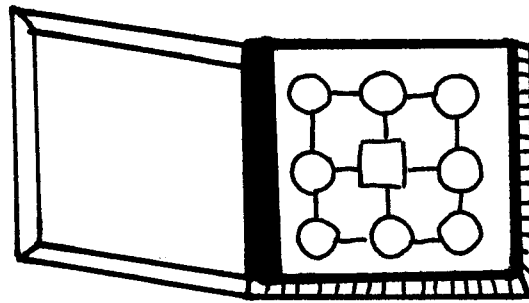
(2) Create a decorative cover for your magnetic CD case and slide under the tabs for the CD case front cover.

(3) Insert a piece of magnetic metal into the back of the CD case (you can find easy-to-cut metal sheets at any hardware store).

(4) On a sheet of paper create a game board or just leave paper blank and insert over metal.



(5) Use letters, words, numbers, symbols, or pictures by attaching magnetic strip to the back. (See Magnetic Poetry for how to do this step.)
