



CITY GRID TRAIL

To cement our knowledge of the city grid we will be **constructing a collaborative photo map of the Melbourne CBD**. You and your group will be assigned a list of **seven locations** in and around the city grid. Your task is to **visit these locations and take photographs**. Some of the locations you are given will instruct you what to focus on, others allow you to choose. **You are encouraged to experiment** with angles - looking out at the street, focusing on the buildings, looking up at the building, etc.

In addition to the seven locations you have been assigned, you need to **take three extra shots** on

your travels throughout the city. These shots are designed to **capture something exciting, beautiful or interesting**. Try to take shots of things that may not be there forever. For example, a busker, a piece of street art, an historic building. **Be sure to record the exact locations** on your sheet to ensure your picture takes its rightful place on the map. **You will need to have all of your locations on the map and checked off by a teacher before you leave today.**

Each group will be given a map of the city. You need to **plan your route before you set off** to maximize efficiency and have it checked off by a teacher.

We will meet **back at school in the Loft at 2pm**. You will be responsible for organising yourselves to return on time. You need to call one of the Galileo teachers if you know you will be late, even by five minutes.

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You will also need to **assign roles in your group**. Each group will need a leader, a map reader, a scribe and a timekeeper.

Leader : Responsible for making final decisions, settling disputes and taking care of the camera.

Leader must also ensure members of the group stay together at all times. The leader is _____

Map Reader: Responsible for reading maps and giving directions. The map reader is _____

Scribe: Responsible for taking notes on each photo, ensuring checklist is completed, recording locations of optional photos. The scribe is _____

Timekeeper: Responsible for keeping track of time, moving project along, getting to school on time. The time keeper is _____
