### Justice Week trails and key classes:

Trail two visited the Occupy Melbourne movement and State Parliament on Wednesday followed by the Magistrates Court of Friday, and trail three focused on homelessness on Wednesday, visiting a real estate agent and a homelessness advocacy organisation followed by the Courts on Friday.

All students did a workshop on the distribution of wealth on Tuesday. Other main classes during the week were taken up with camp preparation.
