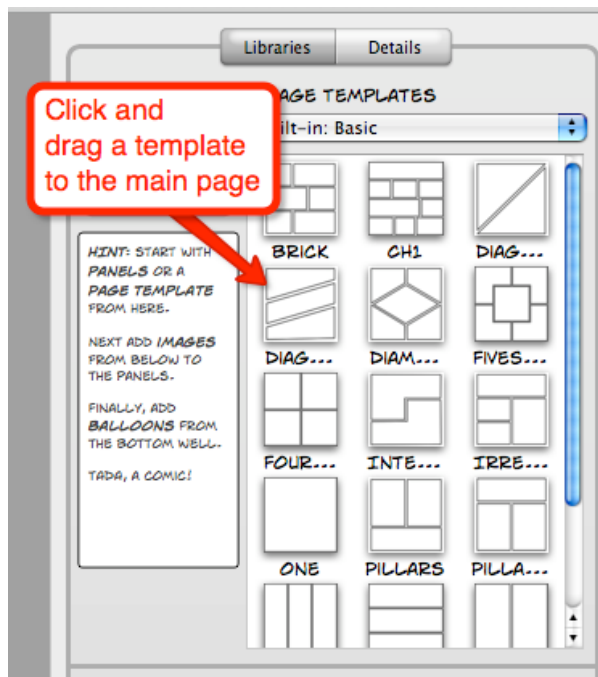


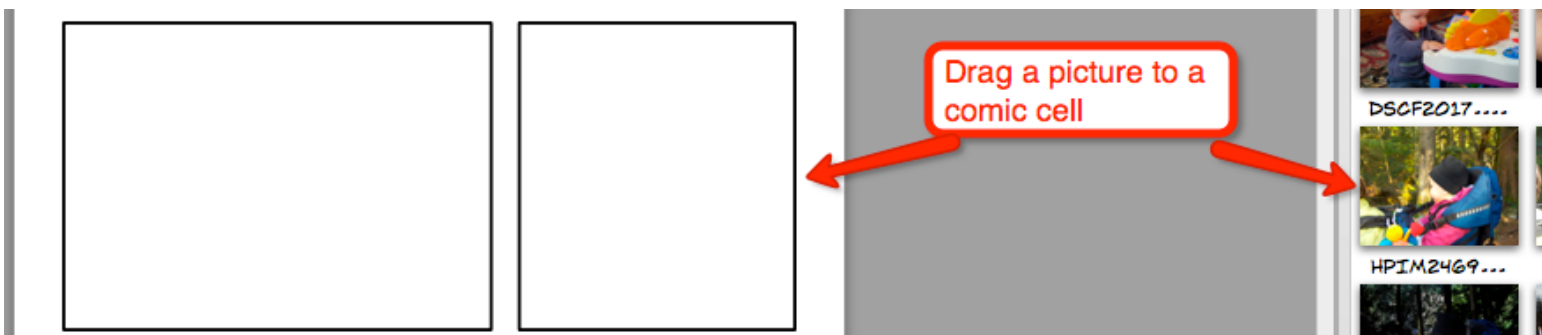

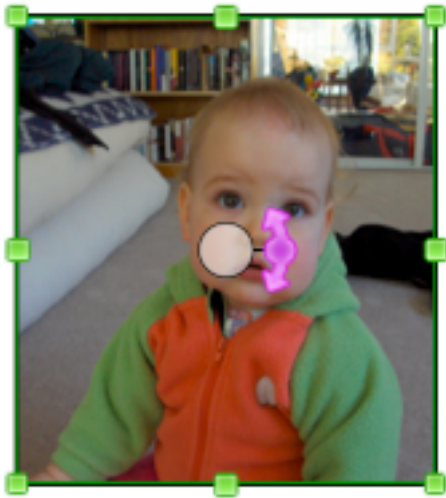
How to Add Pictures to a Comic



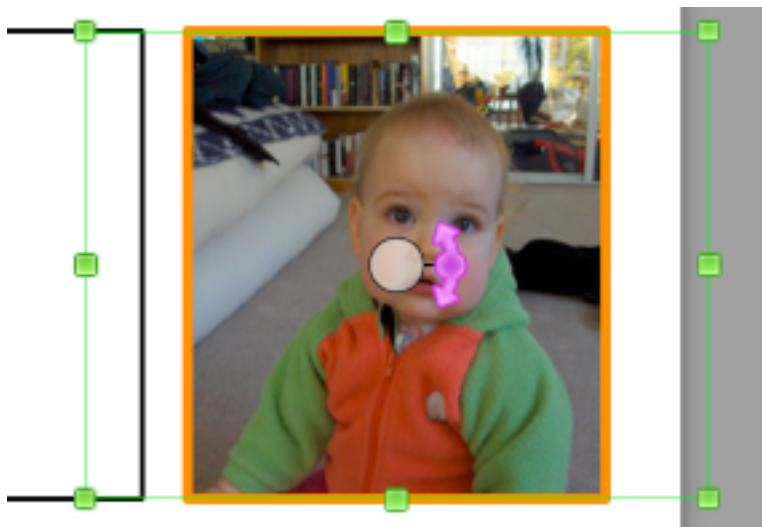
Editing Pictures and Frames

In comic life, you can edit either the frame which contains a picture, or the picture itself. When you edit the frame, you crop more or less of the picture. When you edit the picture, you can expand and shrink the picture (rather than crop it).

When you first click on a picture in a cell, you are able to edit the frame. When you are able to edit the frame, the four points of the frame will be activated:



When you double click on a picture in a cell, you are able to edit the picture. When you edit the picture, the active points are on the corners of the picture (rather than the frame).



To Delete a Page/Add a Page

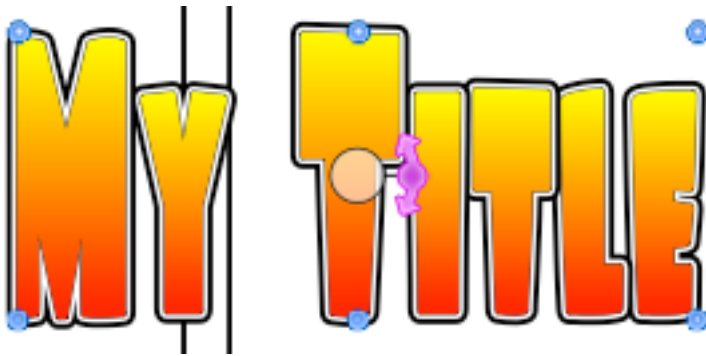
To delete a page, click on **Page → Delete a Page**.

To add a page, click on **Page → New Blank Page**. Then drag a new layout to that page.

Modifying a Title

Once you've placed a title, you can modify it in two ways. You can scale it, or you can warp it.

To warp the title, click on it once. The active corners look as follows (notice the blue circular active corners):



Dragging on these blue corners will simply stretch and warp the title.

To scale a title (once you've warped it), click again on the title. The active corners will change to green squares:
