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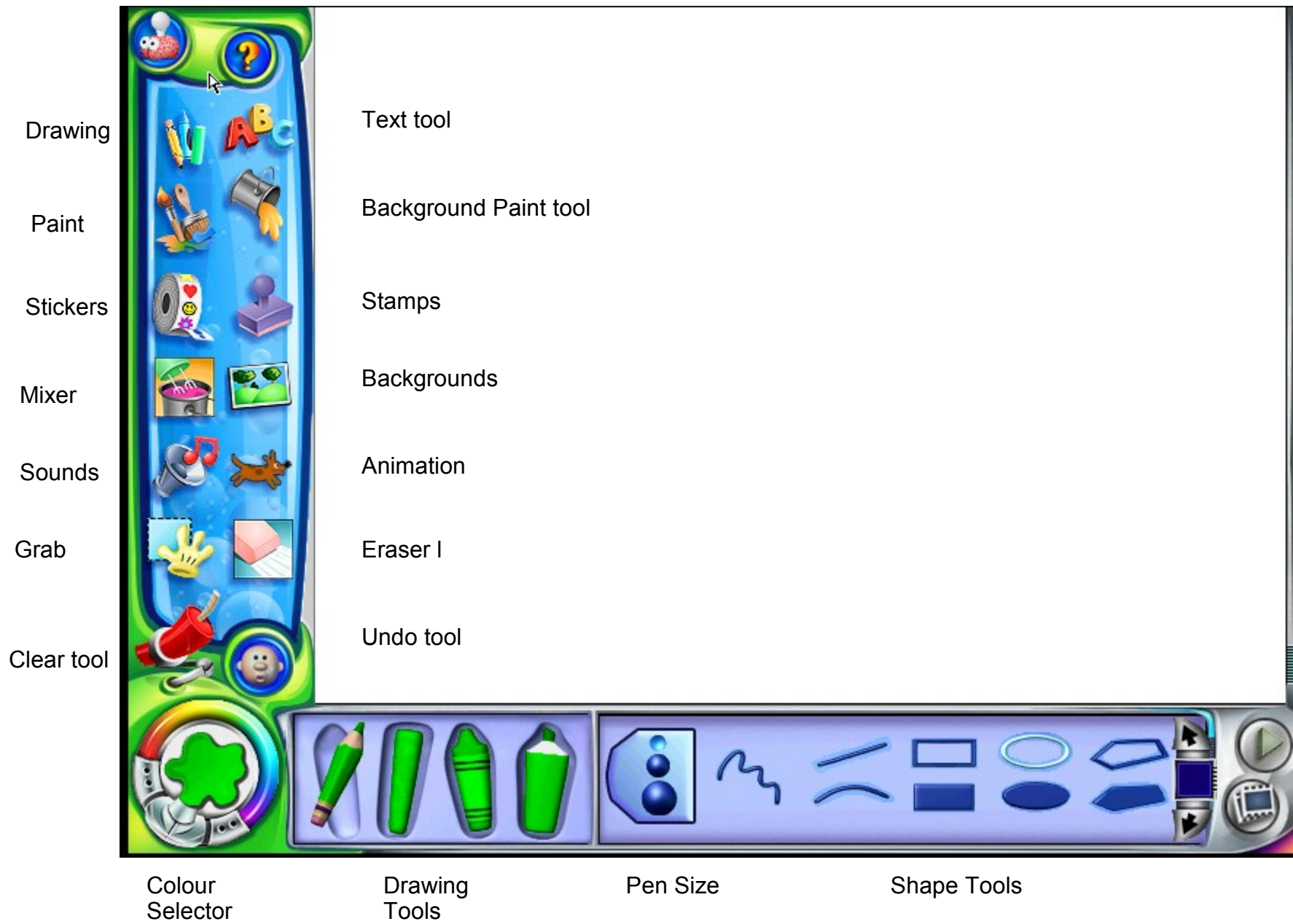

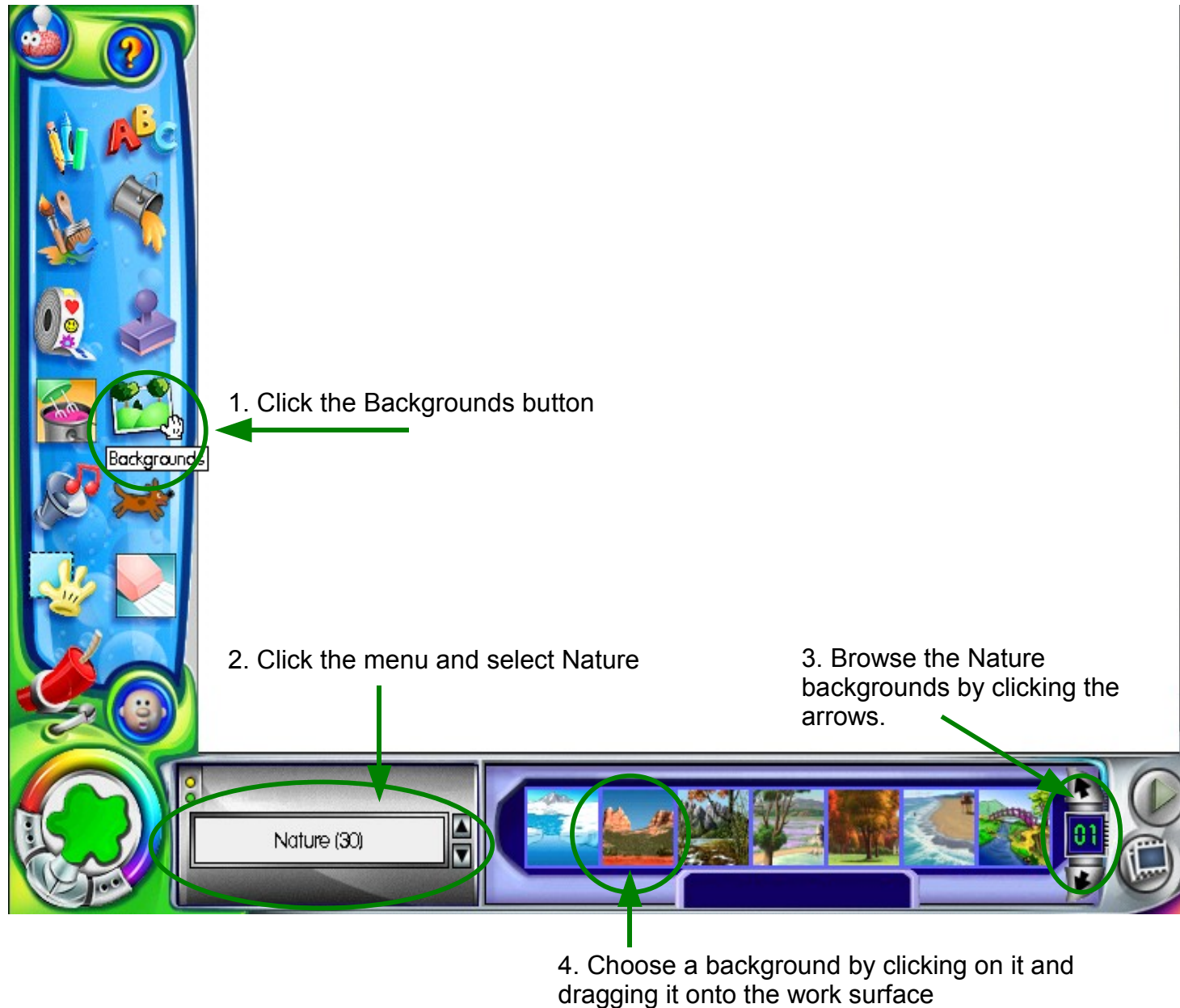

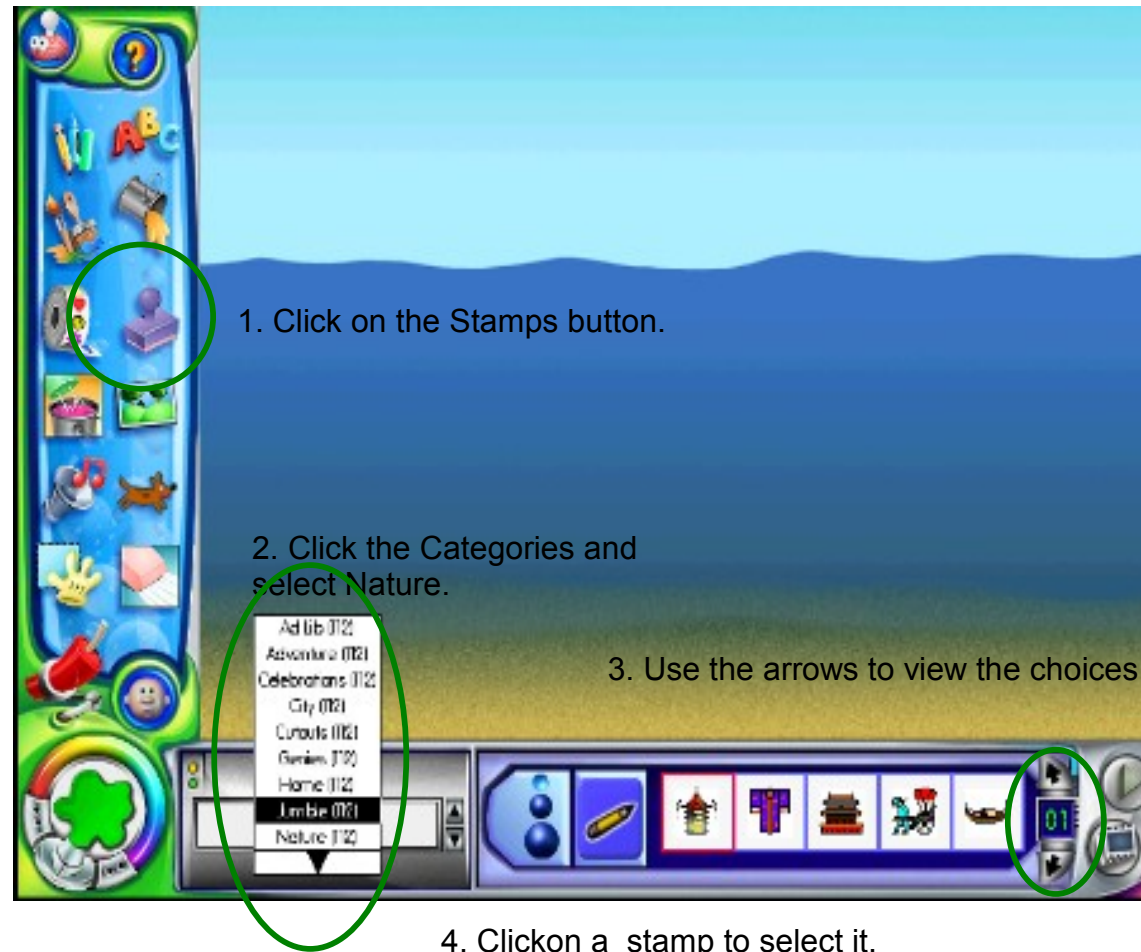
Kid Pix 4 Main Menu



Adding a Background to a Drawing



Adding Stamps to the Picture



4. Click on a stamp to select it.

5. Click on the surface to add the item to the picture

6. Each click will add another copy of the item.

Adding Stickers

Stickers can be resized and rotated once they are placed in the picture.



1. Click the Stickers button.

2. Select a category

3. Use the arrows to scroll through the options.

4. Drag an item onto the image.

Drag to re-size the image



Flips an image horizontally

Flips an image vertically

Drag to re-size the image

Adding Text to an Image

1. Click the text tool.



2. Select a font. 3. Select a font size.

4. Click on the image to open a text box.

5. Add the text.

6. Use the pink handles to resize the text box.

7. Move the cursor to the blue line.

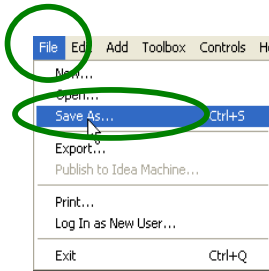
8. It will change into a four way arrow.

9. Click and drag the text box to the proper location.

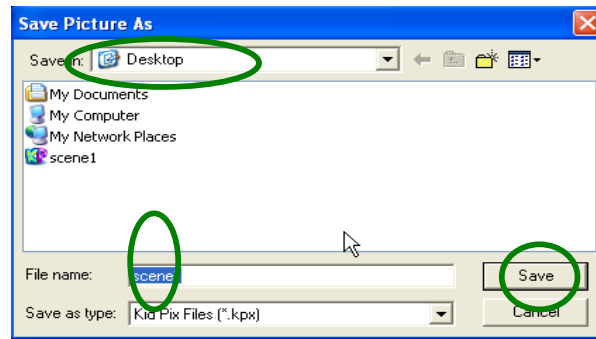
Saving a Kid Pix File

1. Click File

2. Click Save As



3. Choose a location. In this example the image is saved to the Desktop



5. Click Save

4. Give the file a name.

Create a second Drawing using the same instructions. The proceed to the next section where we will join the images into a slide show.

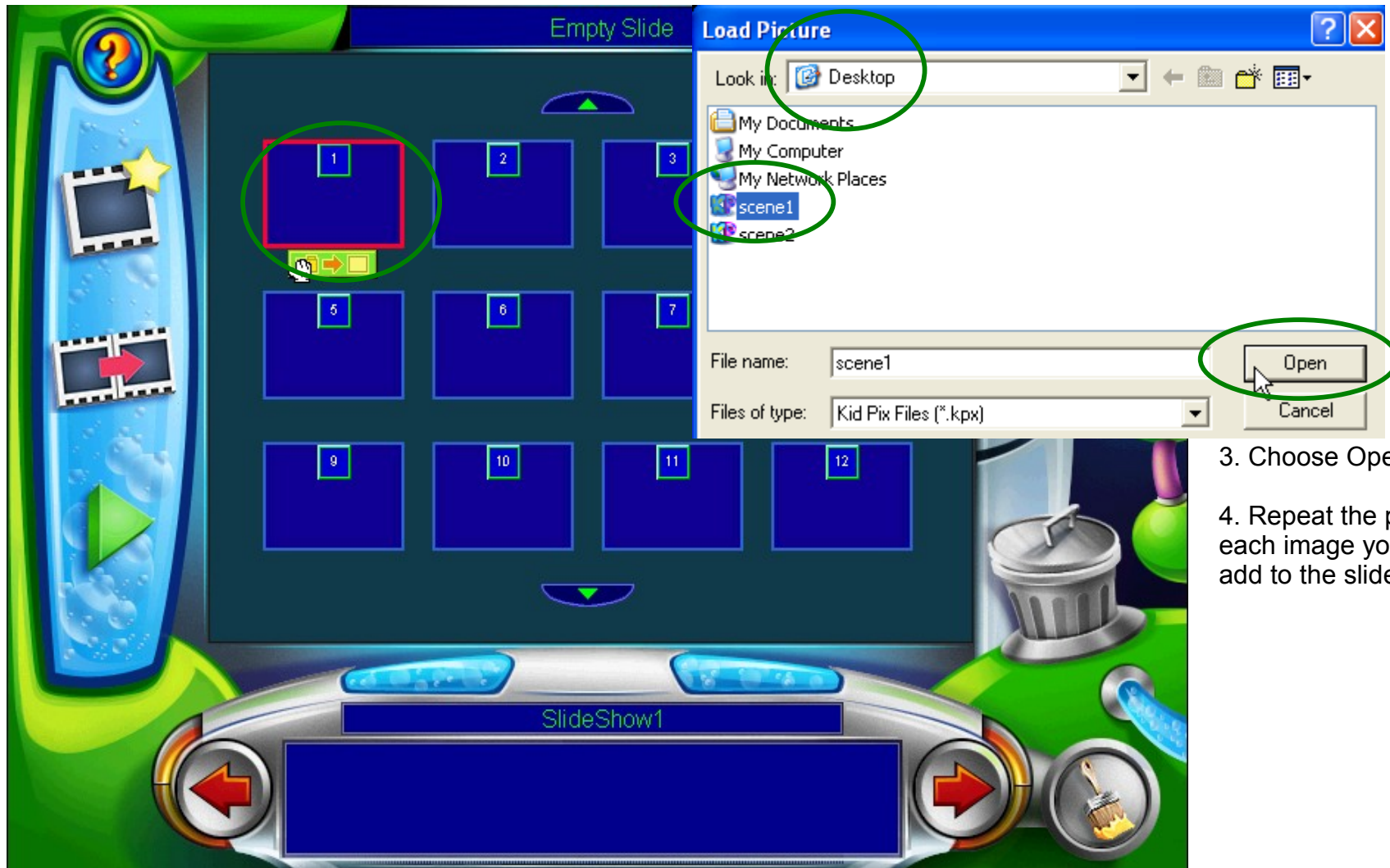
Making a Slide Show



1. Click Go to Slide Show

2. Click the file folder below slide # 1

3. Locate and select your first image.



3. Choose Open

4. Repeat the process for each image you want to add to the slide show



Experiment with the Slide Transition button and click to learn how to change the transition from one slide to the next.
