

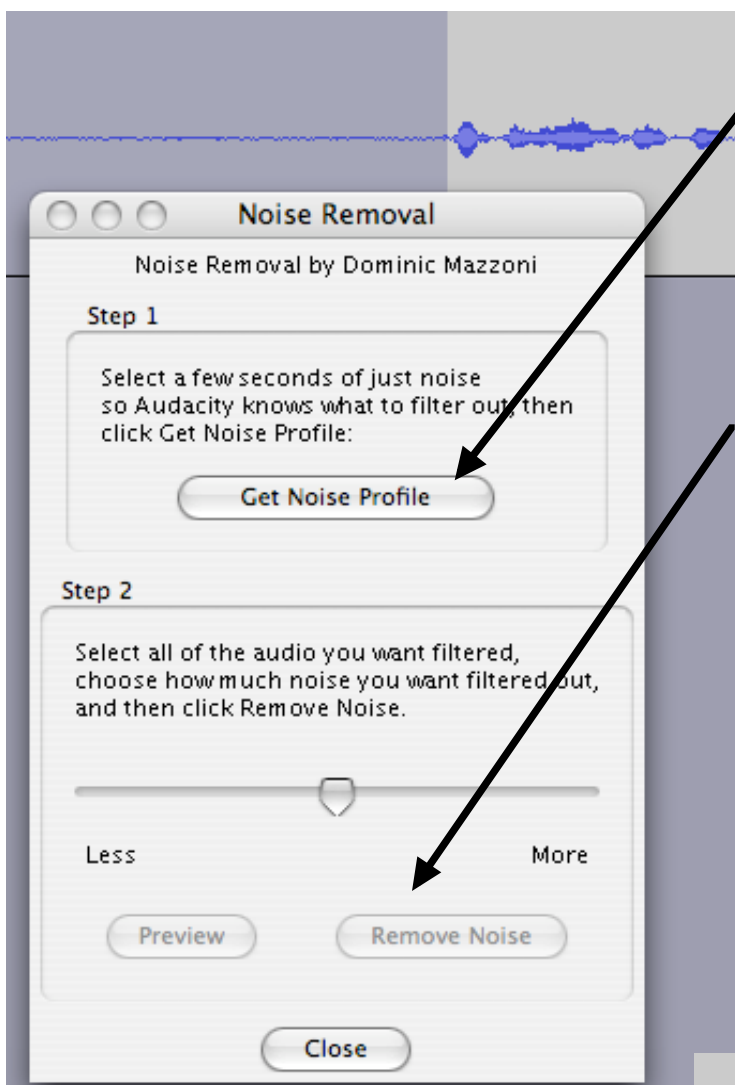


## Steps to Remove Noise in AUDACITY



If you happen to record in a noise room (air conditioner, lights humming, etc.) – there is a way to remove background noises from your recording. Here are the steps:

1. **ALWAYS** record 3 or more seconds of “nothing” before the speaker begins. This establishes the “noise” in the track. Highlight the empty track – and go to Menu bar > Effects > Noise Removal. You will see this dialog box:



2. Click on the “Get Noise Profile” to establish the “noise”.

3. Highlight all the audio that you want to filter (right over the voices or music.)

4. Go to Menu > Effects > Noise Removal and from the dialog box – go to Step 2 and click the Remove Noise. You can slide the “Less or More” button for levels of filter too.

5. Repeat the Remove Noise until you have your desired effects.

This audio track had background noise removed and the audio line is “flatter.”
