

Resource Information for New Students

Creating an account for university computer resources:

Students at PSU have access to free email, computer lab resources, network storage and space for personal web pages. This account is called an ODIN account.

To create an account go to: <https://www.account.pdx.edu/>

To activate your account after you create it go to the HELP Desk in room 18, basement of Smith Center.

myPSU:

The university has created a “portal” for convenient login to all of your PSU resources. myPSU allows you to login with your ODIN login and password and have access to email, PSU calendar, grades and registration, online courses and more. It is also customizable similar to iGoogle or Yahoo.

To set up your myPSU account go to: <https://my.pdx.edu/>

Use the “How do I get a user name and password?” link to set up your login.

NOTE: You need to activate your ODIN account before you can do this.

Printing:

Students are automatically allotted 500 pages to print through the university computer labs. If they go over 500 they are automatically billed for the additional printing. See <http://oit.pdx.edu/policies/printing> for the current pricing and policy information. You can track your printing and access the web printing service that allows you to print from a laptop when on campus at <https://print.pdx.edu>.

Tk20:

The Graduate School of Education (GSE) uses Tk20 as its data management system. Some program assignments and all field experiences are entered into Tk20 to facilitate licensure and data collection. Tk20 costs \$103 for 7-8 years of access. You can purchase it online using credit card, cashier's check or money order, or you can purchase it through the PSU Bookstore (\$133). Metropolitan Instructional Support Laboratory (MISL)

The MISL is the media, resource and computer lab maintained by the Graduate School of Education. The lab houses two computer labs, a classroom, a resource library, and AV equipment for loan. You can also purchase some media supplies and photocopies there. The lab is open throughout the year, though schedules vary from term to term and during breaks.
