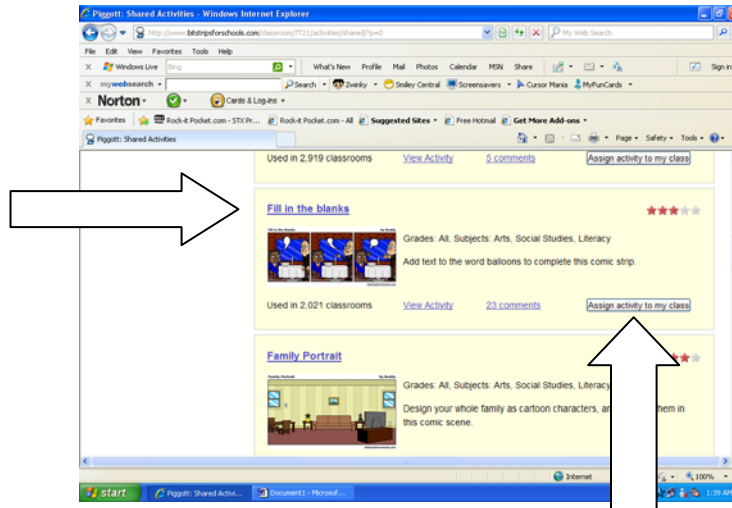

Choose an activity or create your own and assign it to your class:

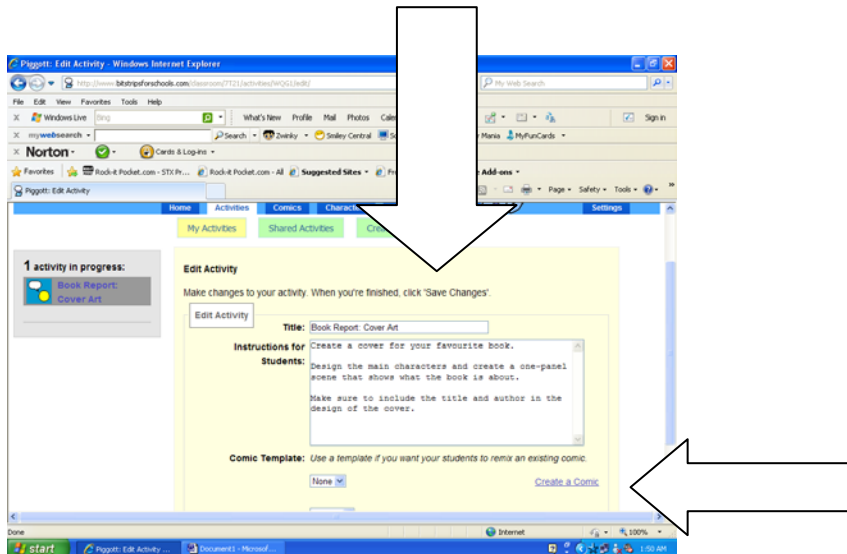
Click on activity to see description, instructions for students and comments by teachers

This comic strip task can now be assigned to students.

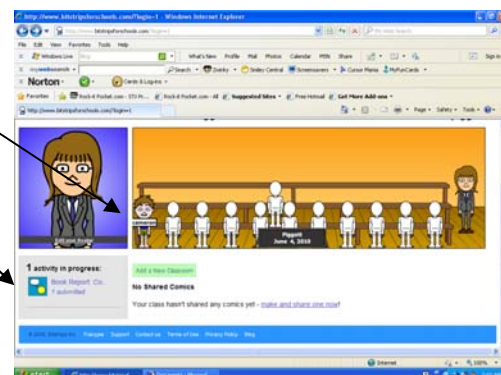
**This would work great as a guided reading activity.** The link can be copied into 'assignments' for students in their 'class work' on 'school connects'.

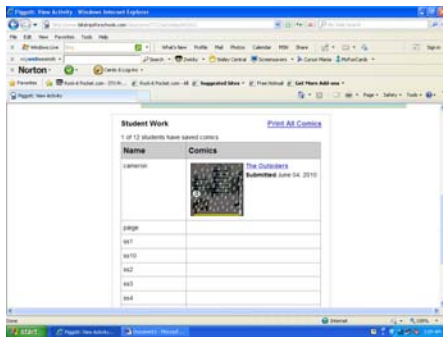
Days later: The students have worked on their comics.

They are complete and the teacher is ready to assess and provide feedback.

Teacher logs back into site. Teacher can see who has created their avatar.

The teacher can also see how many assignments have been completed and handed in. By clicking on assignments submitted, the teacher can assess, provide feedback and print if needed,

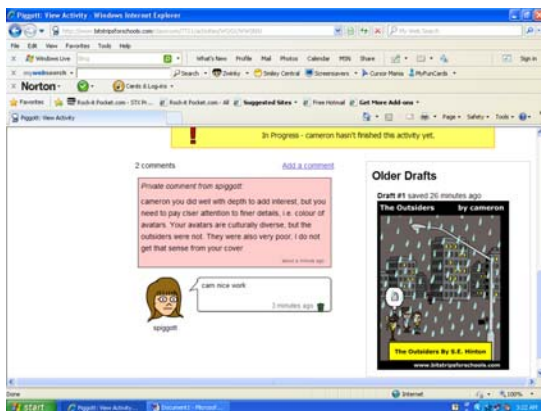




Now the teacher can look at the student work by clicking on it.



Teacher comments as well as the look on the teachers face can be posted for the student to receive feedback.

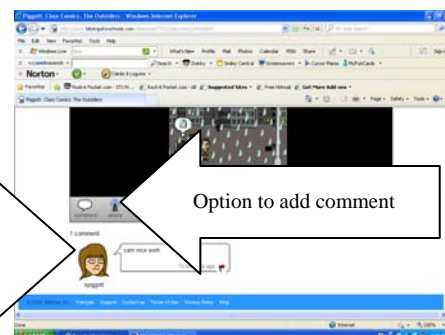
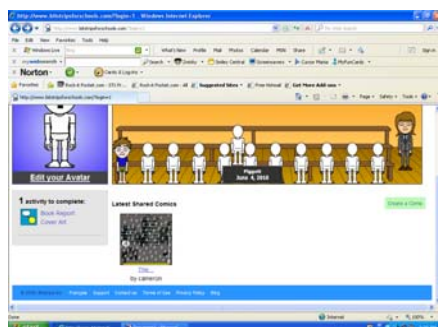


The teacher feedback can be posted for all students to see. This may be helpful to encourage a higher level of work or illustrate a specific technique to other students.

Teacher feedback can also be just provided to the student. This would be where teachers could express more specific strengths and areas of concern.

The assignment can then be sent back for the student to incorporate teacher feedback.

FYI – When another student logs on, they can see the in progress or completed works that the teacher has posted to the class. When a student selects another student's assignment to look at, they see the assignment as well as the posted feedback. Student can then also comment on the assignment.
