

Philosophy of Teaching with Technology

The first item on the Educational Technology Page of your Portfolio should be your philosophy of using technology in teaching. Below are a few things for you to consider as you write this philosophy:

- ❖ It should be no longer than 150-200 words, approximately one quality paragraph.
- ❖ Make sure your grammar is perfect (employers will eventually look at this so you want it perfect)
- ❖ Your philosophy is personal; discuss your feelings on the importance of technology in an educational setting.
- ❖ Be honest, enthusiastic, and straightforward (clear) – say what you mean; leave the platitudes for politicians.
- ❖ Include a description of how you want to teach with technology.
- ❖ Include why you want to teach with technology
- ❖ Think about these questions: What is learning and how does technology fit in? What are your goals for your students?
