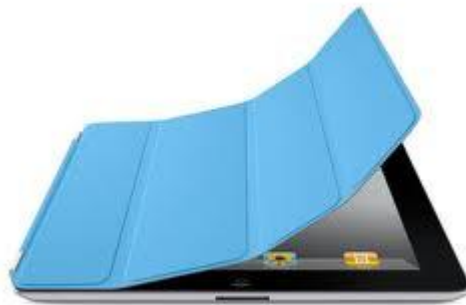


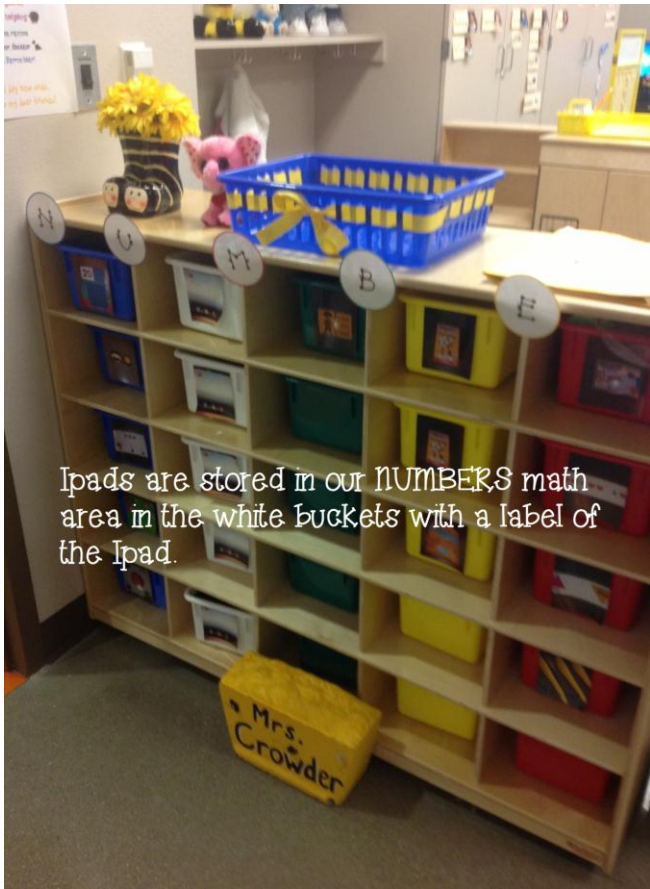

iPad Management Tips



Ipads are stored in our NUMBERS math area in the white buckets with a label of the iPad.



IPads are stored in these buckets and students carry them safely inside..



It's your "appy" day

I choose who will use the Ipads each day by pulling 5 sticks from this bucket. A red dot facing up means that student has already used the Ipads recently. I make sure to pull students with a green dot facing up. Once every stick shows a red dot facing up, then I know I need to flip them all over and start again.

(PreK-2nd)

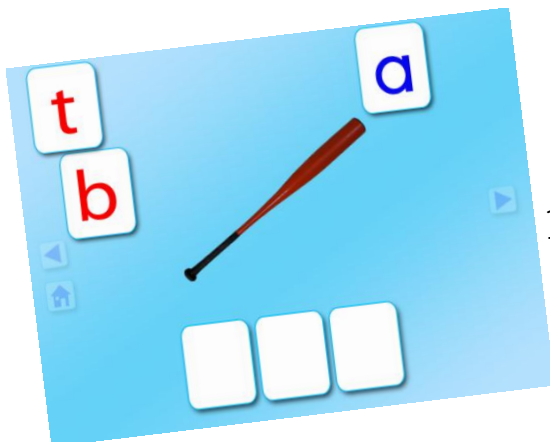
Students record and write sight words, spelling words, or letters

Word Family Tree

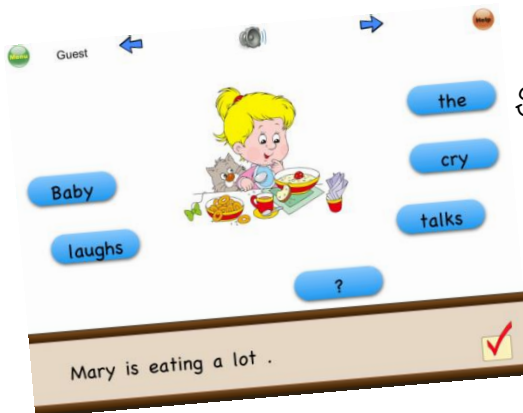

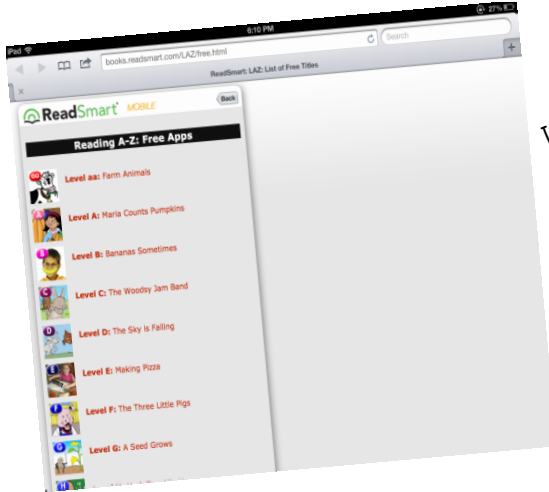

Sock Puppets*

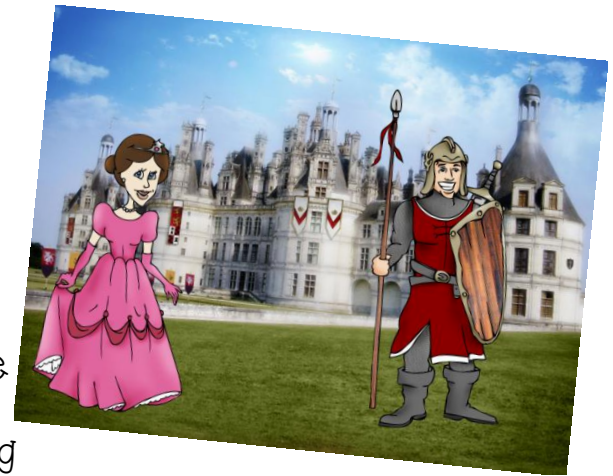
