



How to Increase your Flip Camera's Audio Quality on your PC using Windows Movie Maker 2.6

This manual is a supplement to the video we produced explaining how to increase the overall quality of your Flip videos by increasing the audio quality using Windows Movie Maker 2.6.

While I did use the PC edited files and even recorded the screen capture using Camtasia on my PC I wasn't 100% satisfied with the end result. I tried to make the final edits using Final Cut Pro, and that just mucked everything up even further. I still released the video knowing that this report will help clarify any questions and the value provided far outweighed the cons. If you have any further questions please feel free to post a comment on our blog under this topic and we will respond to your question.

I normally don't shoot my videos using a Flip camera, but I do see valuable use for them, especially for beginners and quick interviews / testimonials. In our testing to create this training, I've noticed that indoor audio sounds better than outdoors, and if you are more than about 7-10 feet from the Flip Camera the audio is severely degraded.

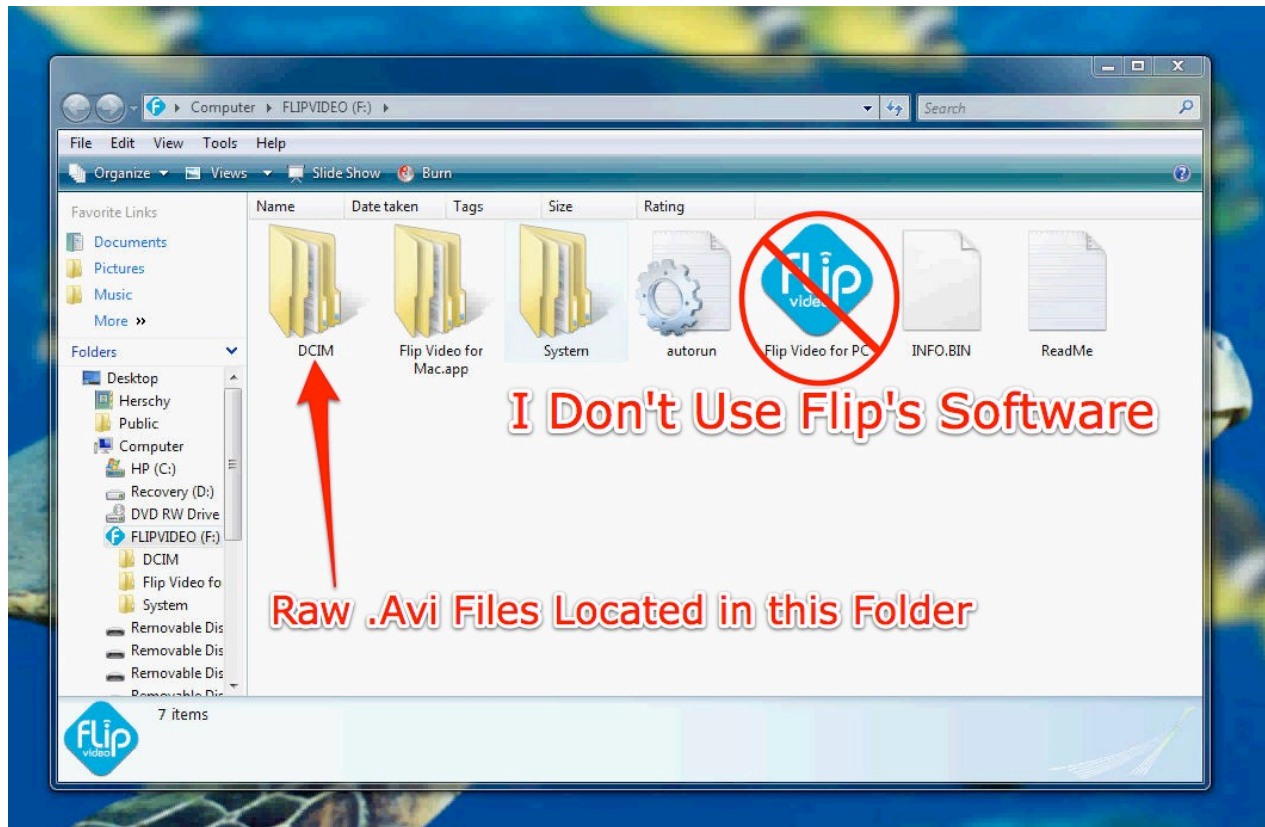

16 Quick and Easy Steps to increasing the audio of your Flip videos

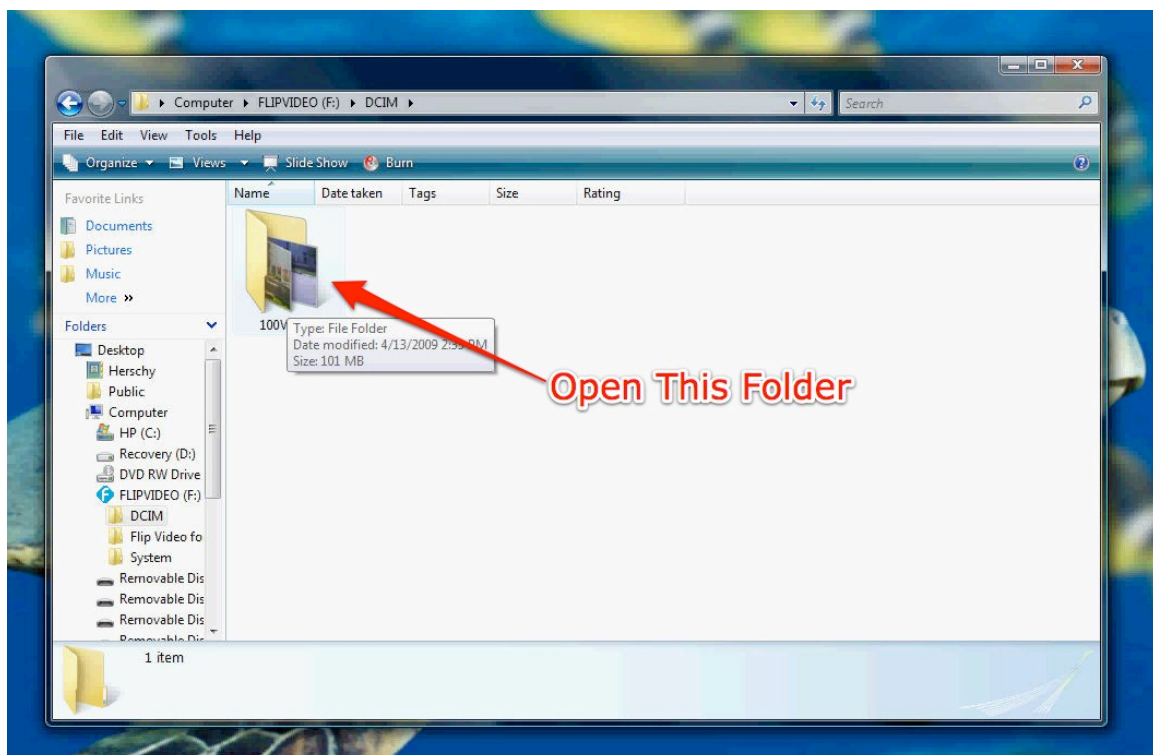
Step 1. Plug your Flip Camera into the USB port of your computer

Step 2. Open up the Flip Camera external drive/ folder. Mine was Computer/F: (FlipVideo). Yours may be slightly different

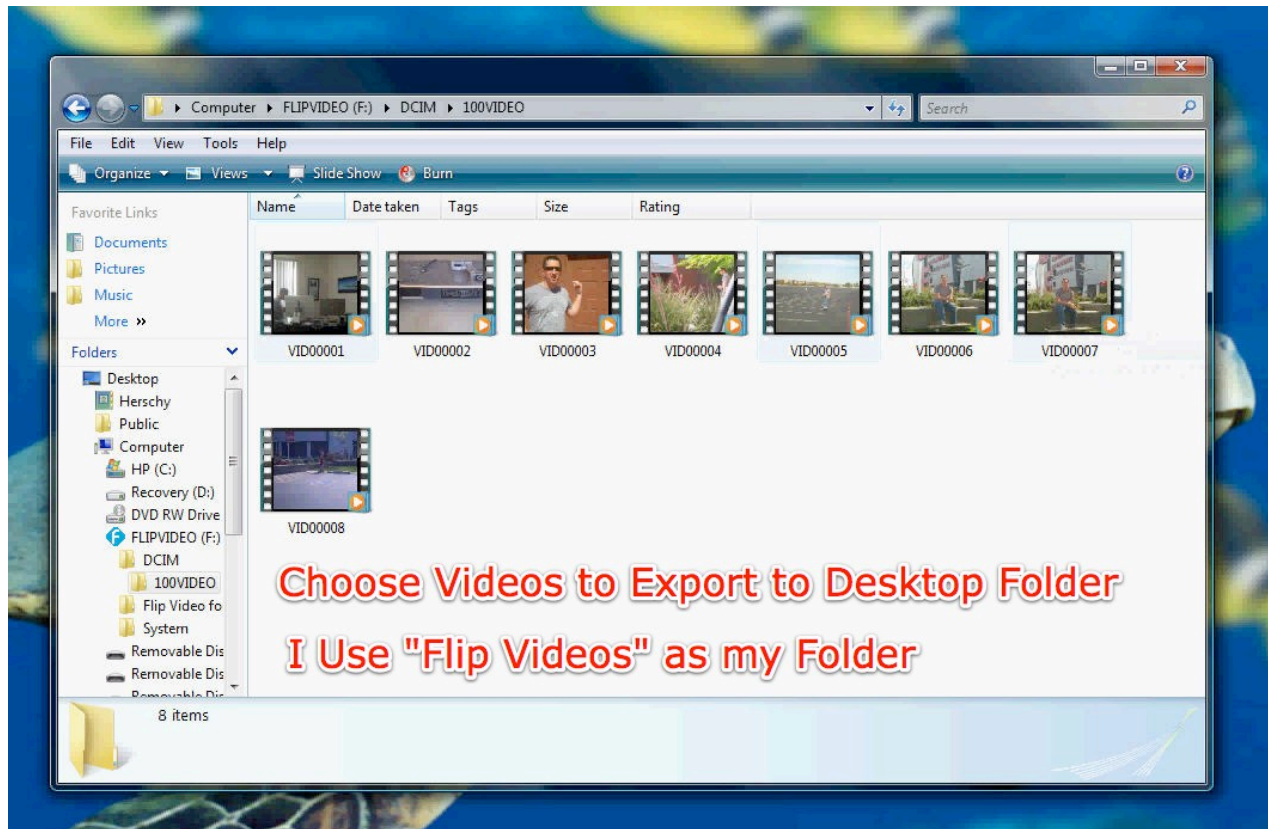
Step 3. Click on the DCIM Folder. I do not use their pre installed software.



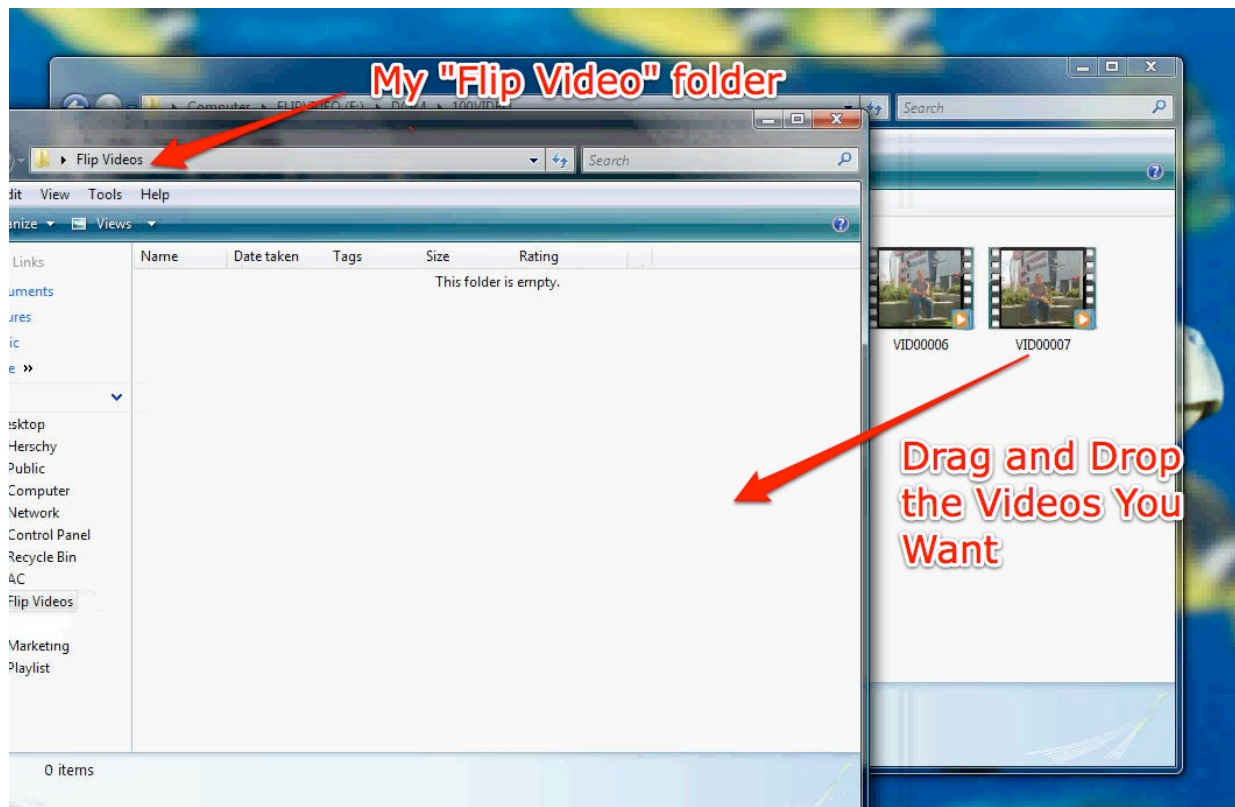
Step 4. Open the Sub Folder in your DCIM folder. This is normally named 100Video and will contain your videos.



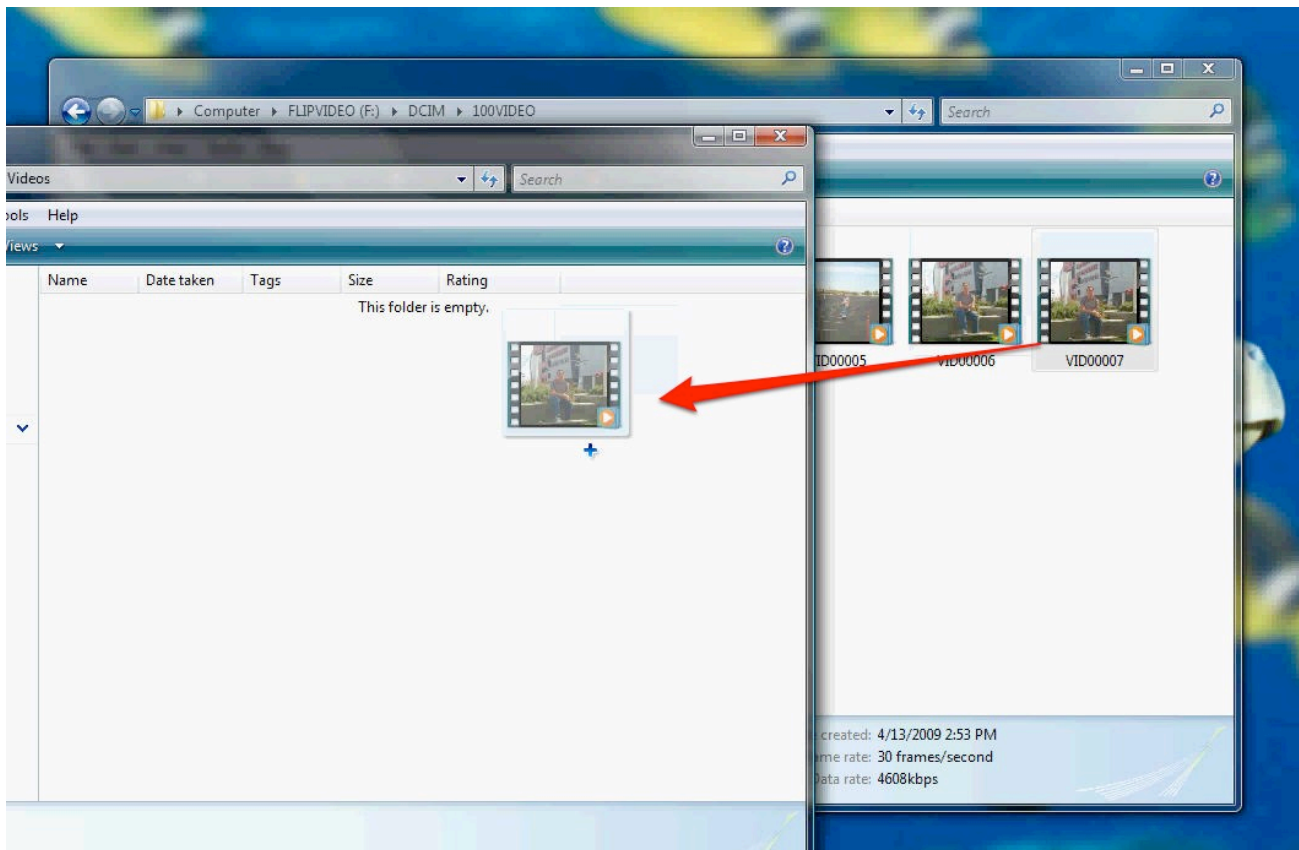
Step 5. Pick the videos you wish to export



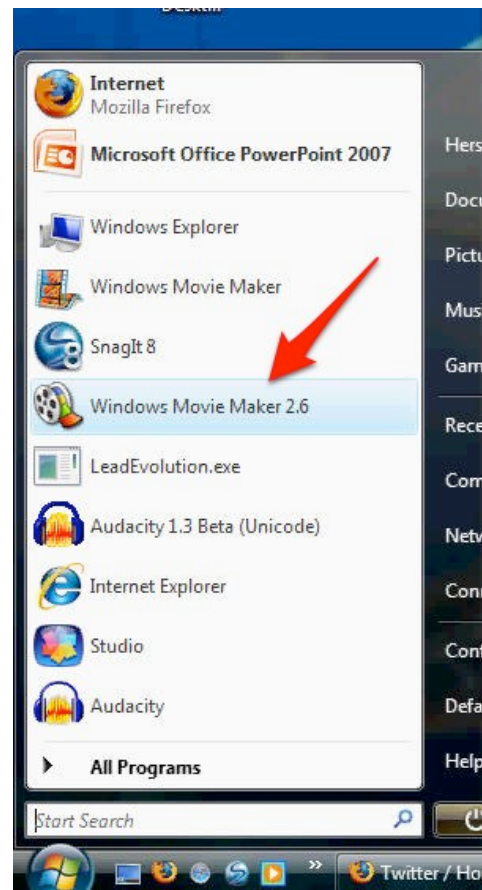
Step 6. Open up the PC Folder you wish to save your videos on.



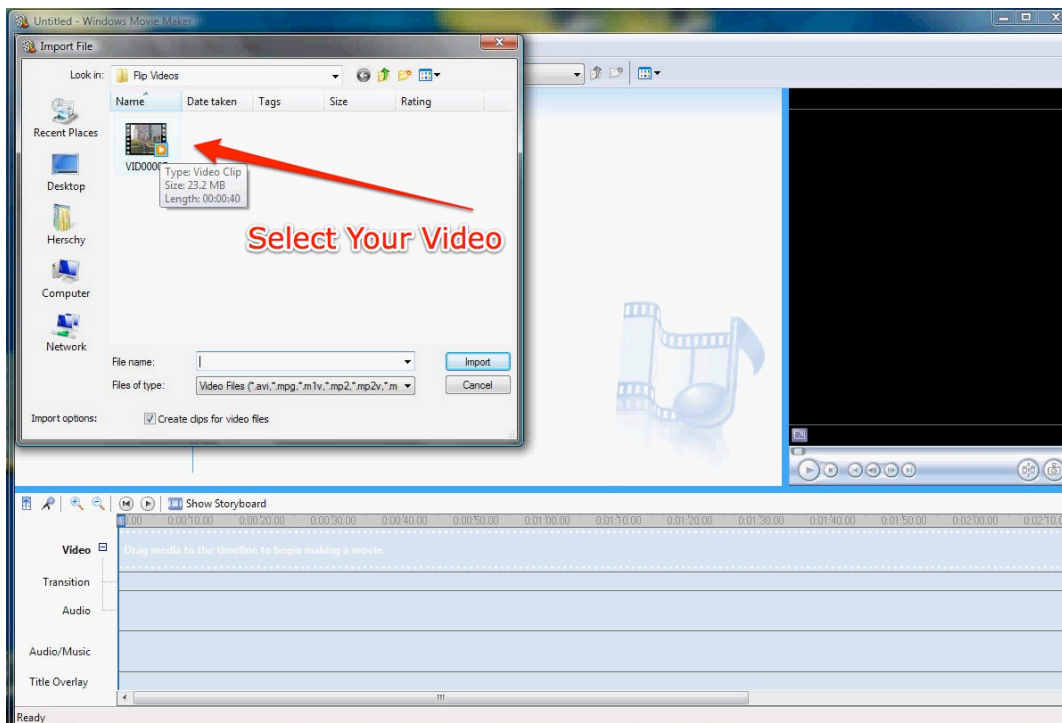
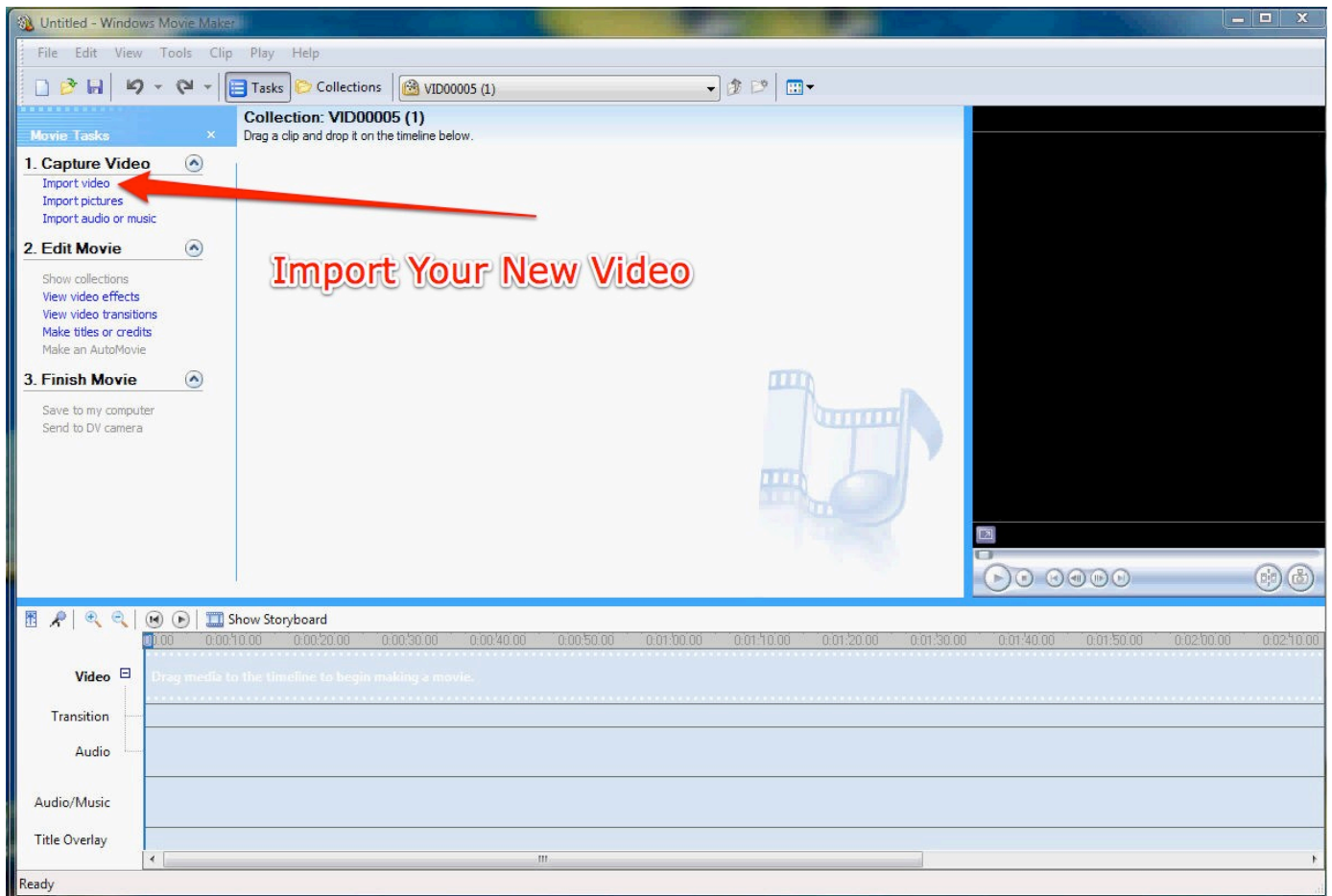
Step 7. Drag and Drop or Copy/Paste the desired videos to the new folder.



Step 8. Open up Windows Movie Maker 2.6

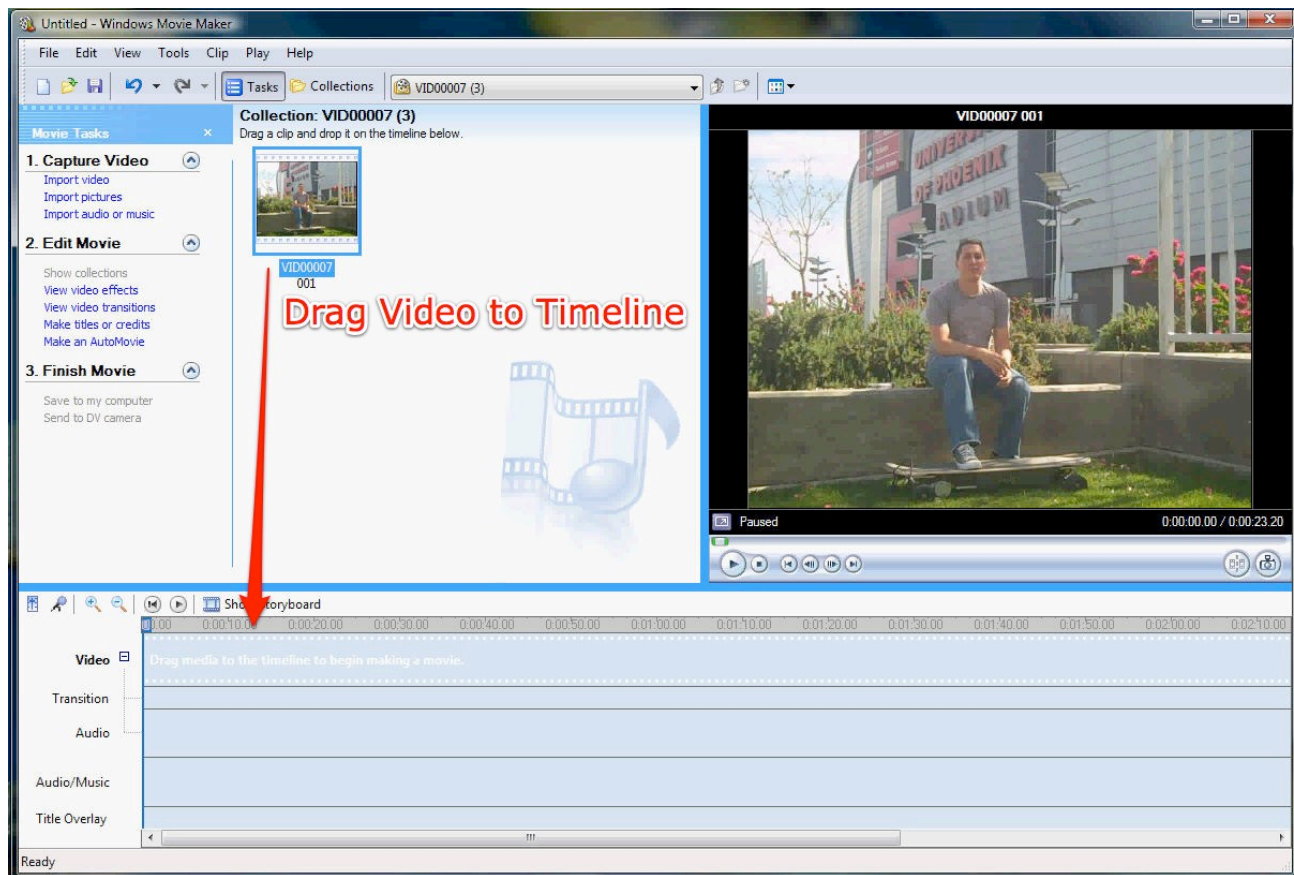


Step 9. Click on the “Import Video” link in Movie Maker to import your video

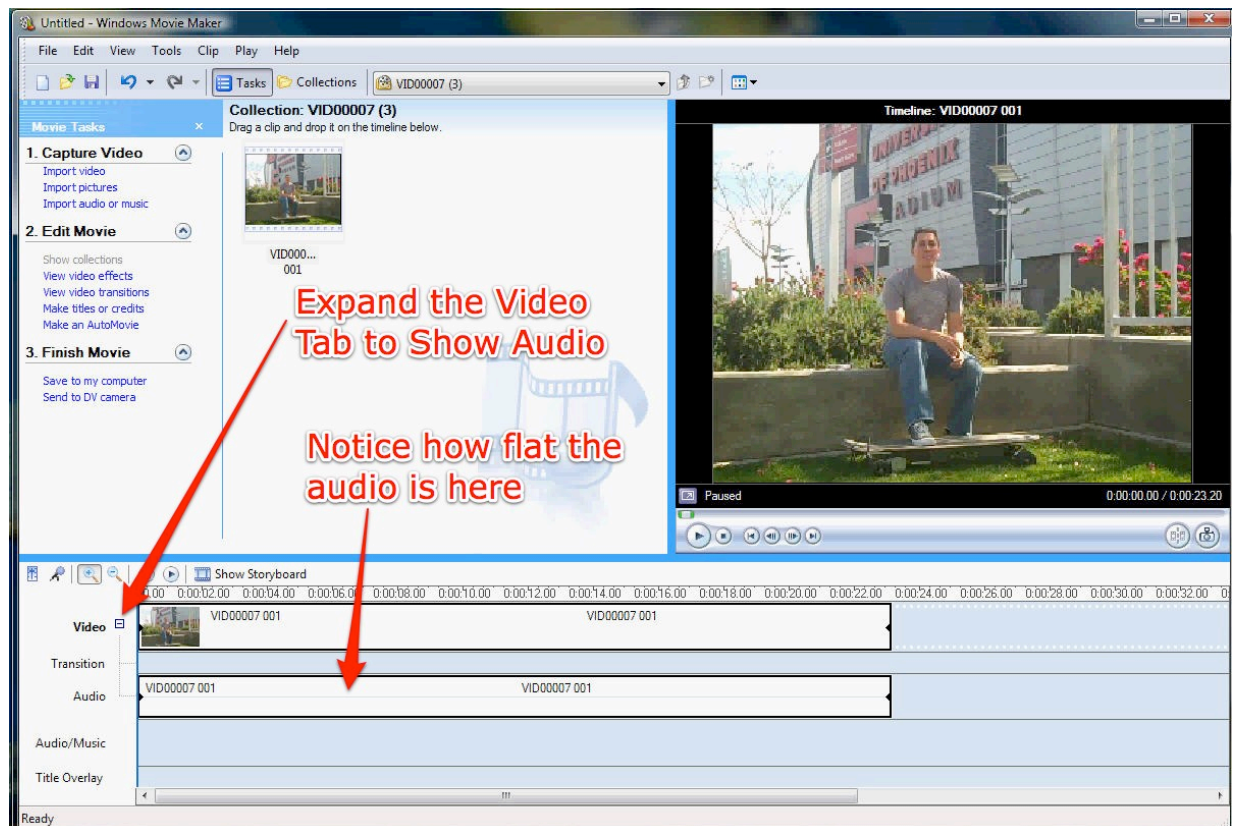


Step 10. Select
Your Video to
Import

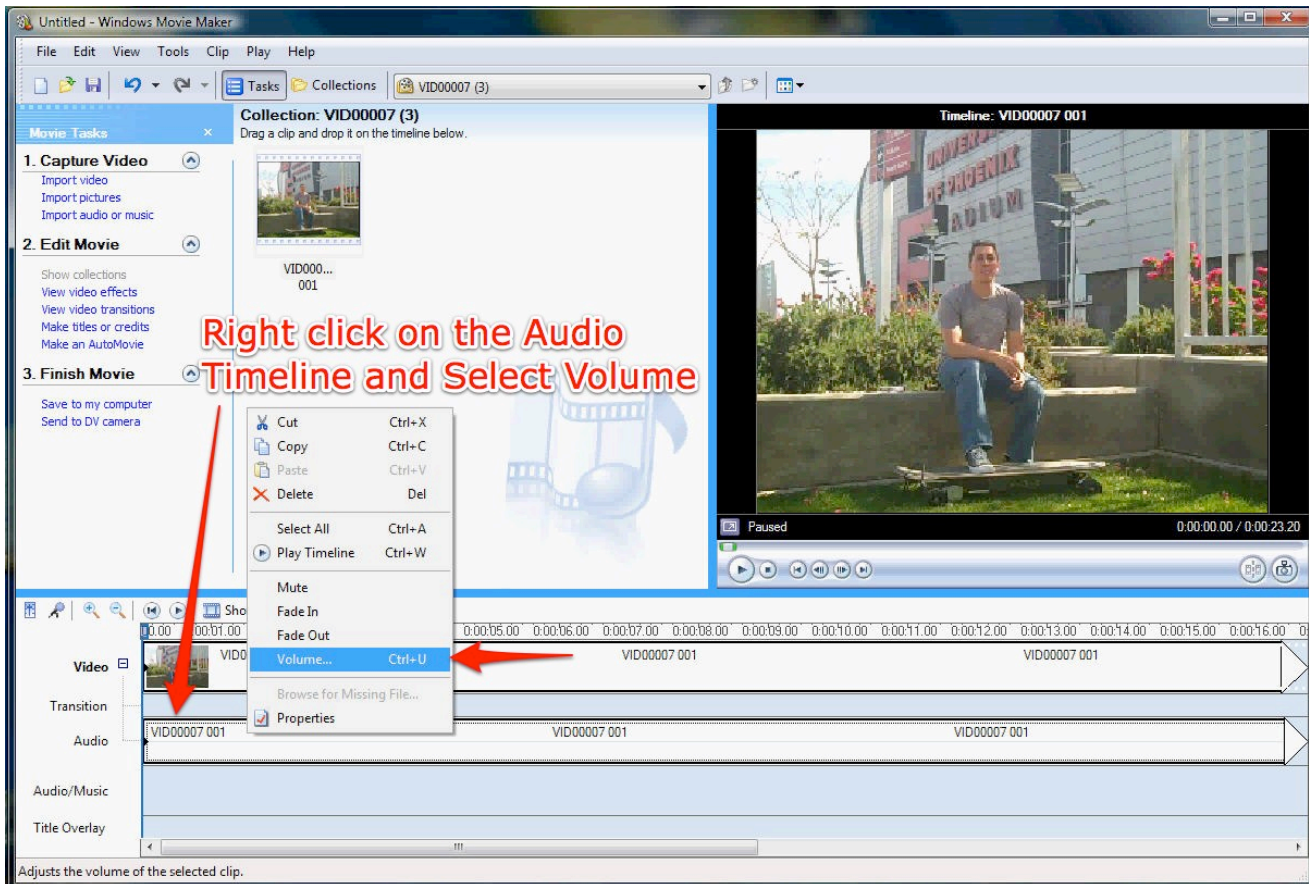
Step 11. Drag and Drop your Video to the Timeline



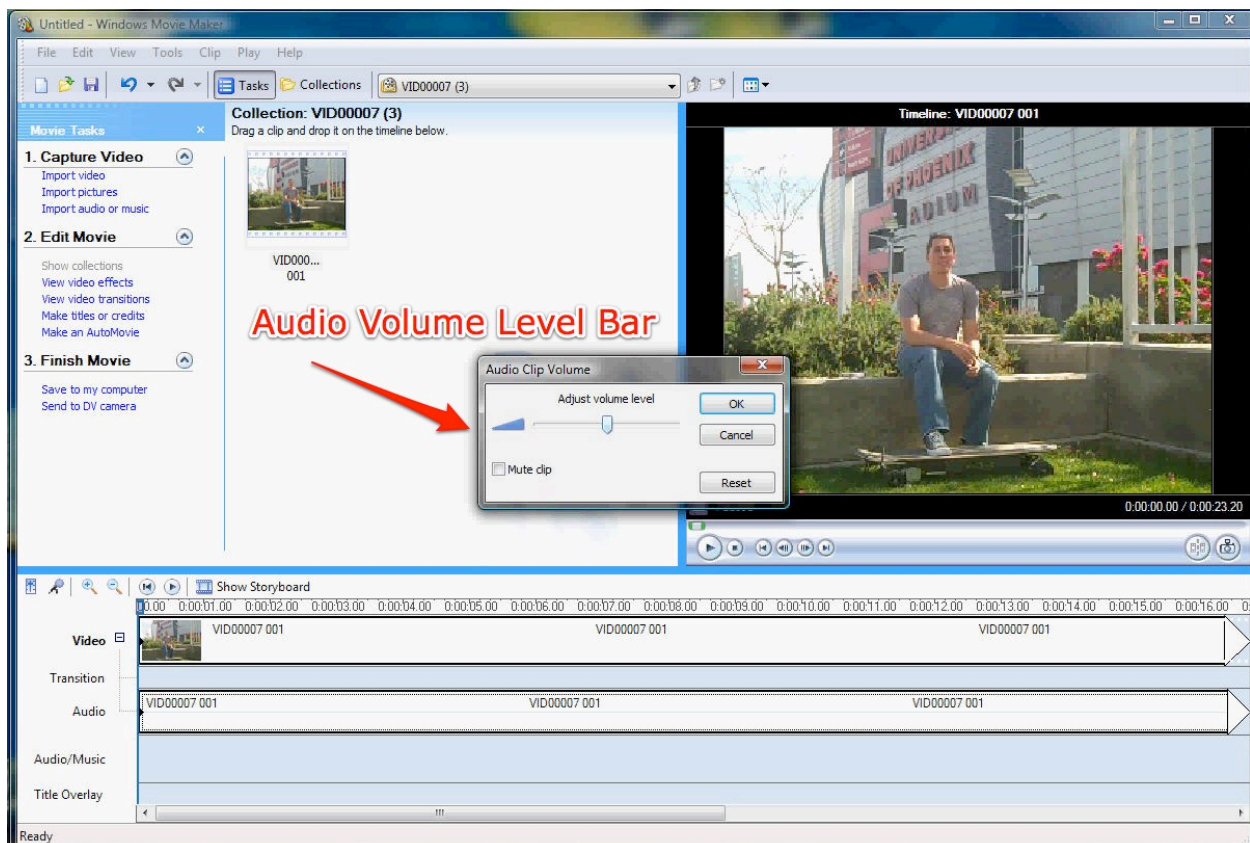
Step 12. Click on the “+” to expand the Video Timeline to see the Audio

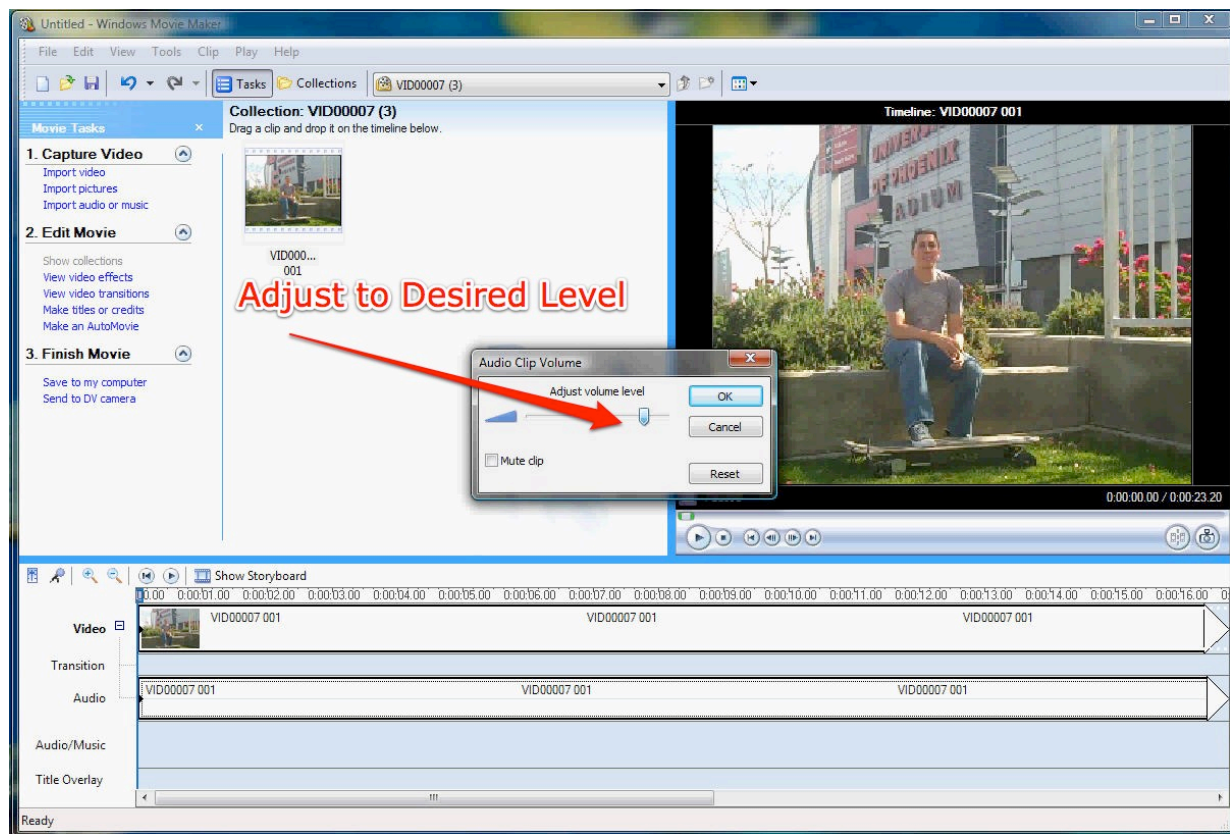


Step 13. Right Click on the Audio Timeline and Select the Volume Option

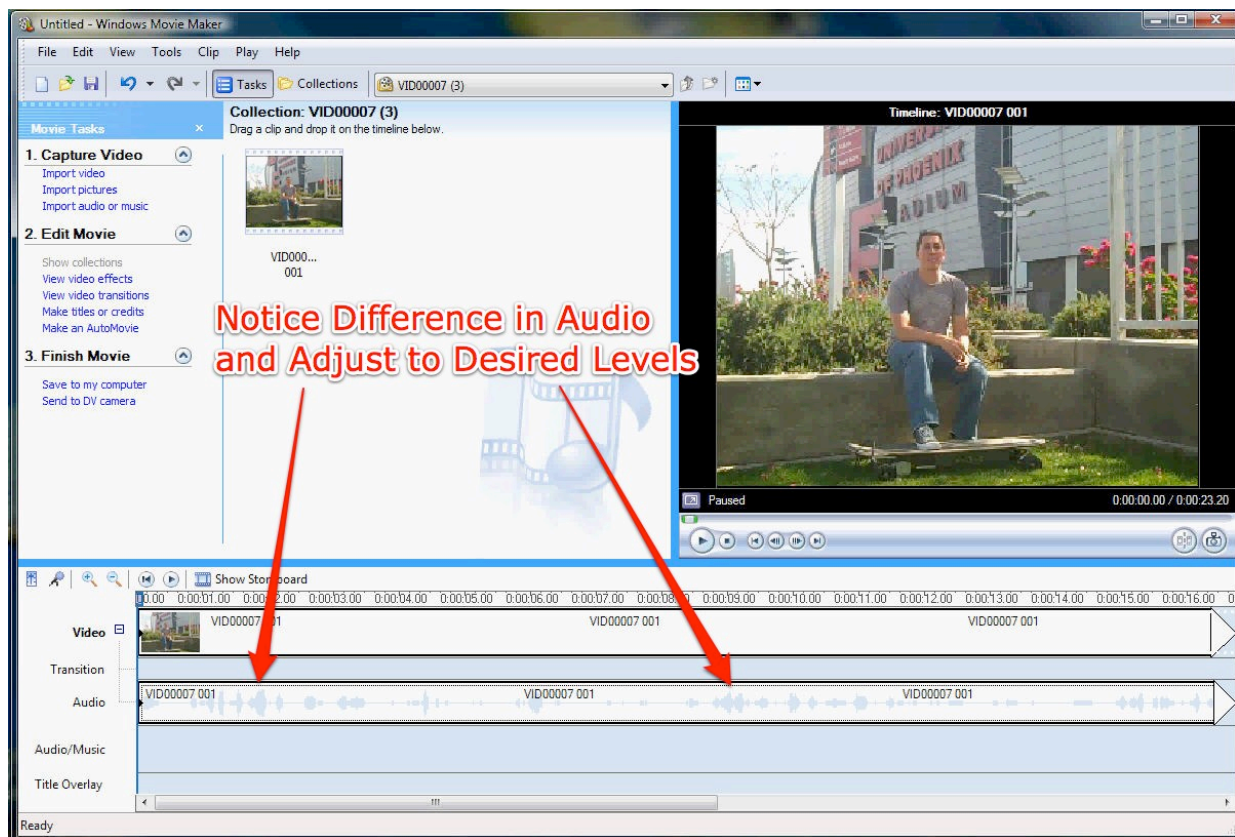


Step 14. Adjust the Audio to the desired level

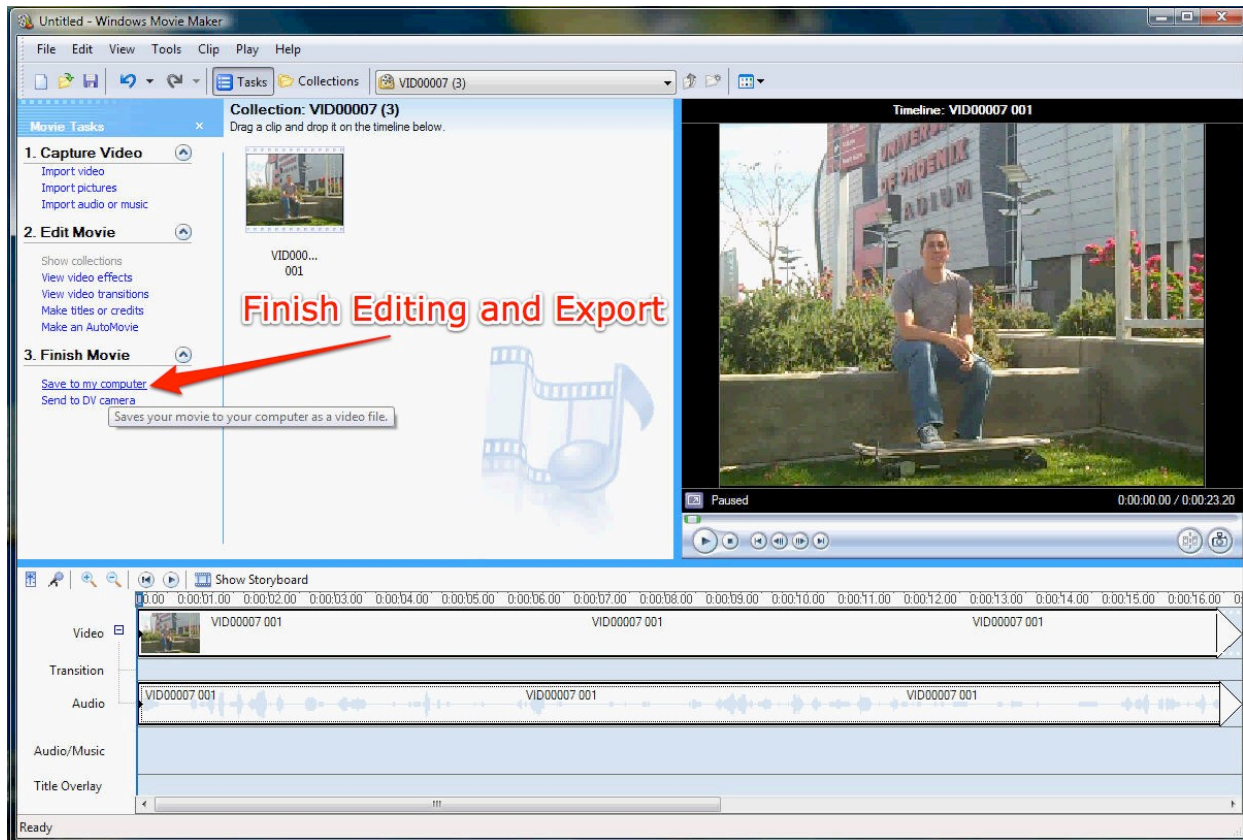




Step 15. Click “OK” and test the audio adjustment



Step 16. Edit Normally and Export the enhanced movie file when finished
