

## Help Document- Face time

Face time can only be used by people with Apple products such as the iPhone 4 or newer iPhone, iPod 4 or newer, second generation iPad or newer, or a computer with Mac OS X. It is not available for older products or from other brands.

\*You must be connected to Wi-Fi or have cellular data connection to use Facetime.

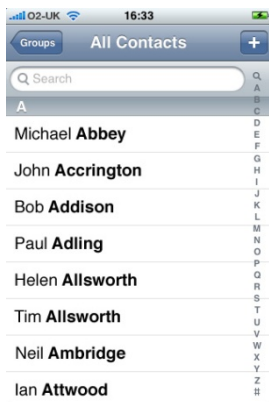
On Facetime for the iPhone, you don't need an account or a screen name to use Face Time, just an activated iPhone.

### How to Call Someone on the iPhone

There are many ways to video chat someone using Facetime, here is one way:

Go to your contacts list and choose a contact to call

1. Once you are on the contact's information screen, tap the Facetime button to call them.



If you have an iPhone 4S or a newer version, you can tell Siri to “Facetime with (your contact's name)”



IPad 2/ Mac OS X or newer-

\*Since the IPad is not a phone, Facetime needs to be associated with an email to work.
