

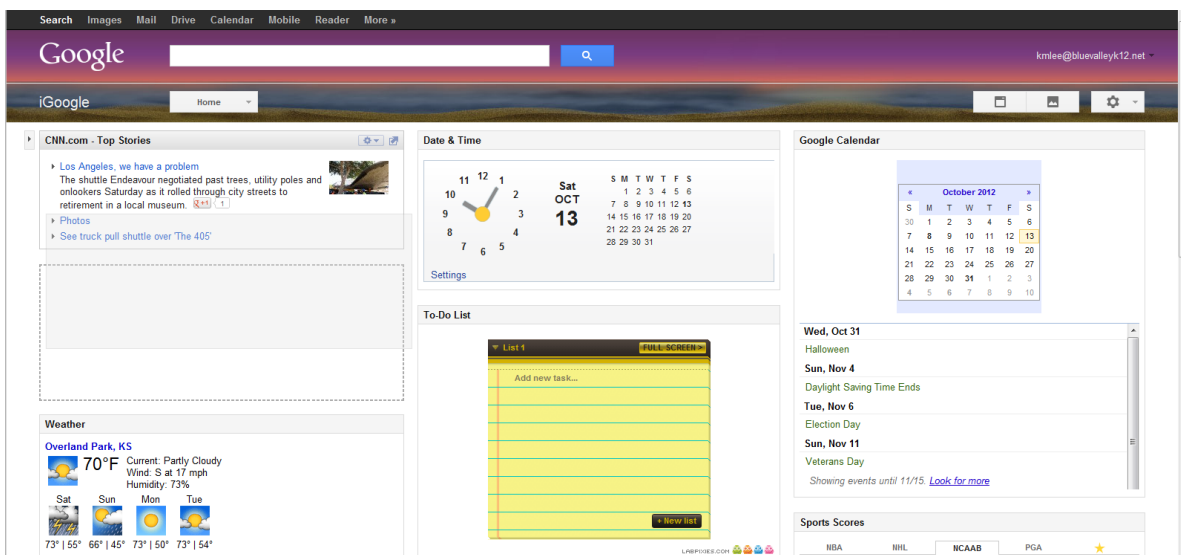
How to Move your Gadgets

Go to iGoogle

Click and hold on the top of the gadget that you want to move



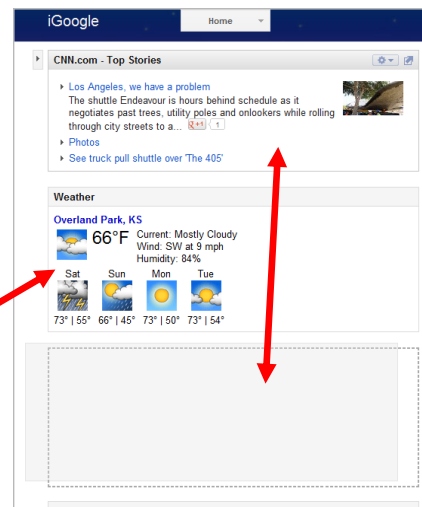
And drag to where you want it



Tip - If you are moving one from the top to the bottom you might need to move it a lot farther than you think
