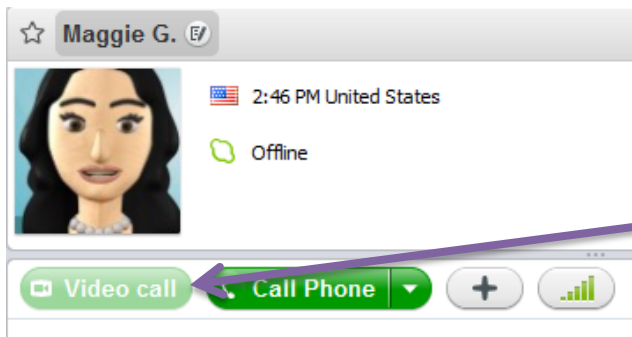
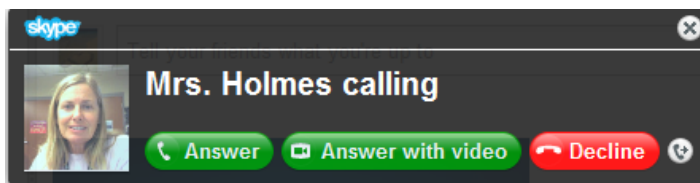


VIDEO CHATING



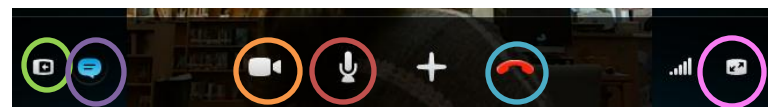
To be able to video call someone they must be online. To know whether or not the person you want to talk to is online is very simple. If they are offline then the video call button will look like this. If they are online Skype will let you click this button.

This screen will show up when you are calling your friend until they answer.



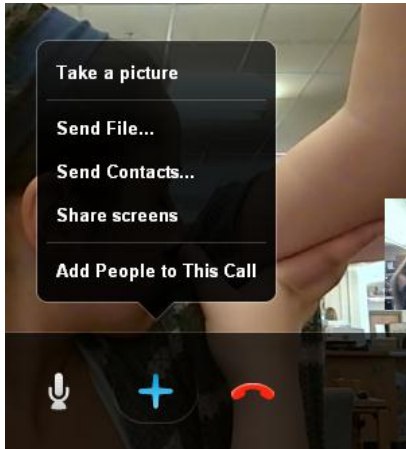
When someone is calling you your screen will look like this. To video chat answer their call by pressing the answer with video button. To just chat with audio click the plain answer button. If you don't feel like talking to the person click the decline button. Or let it ring.

Once you have answered a call you will have these buttons at the bottom of the screen. The first button that is circled in green lets you see all your other contacts while video chatting. The button circled in blue lets you IM people while you are video chatting.



The button circled in orange turns your video off so the other person can't see you. The button circled in red is the mute button so your friend can't hear you. The button circled in blue is the end call button.

The plus button is complicated so I will explain it in the next step. The button circled in pink makes your screen larger.



The plus button can do many things. Once you click it this will show up. You can take a picture of the friend you are Chatting with, you can send a file like a word document or file, you can send contacts, you can share screens so your friend sees what's on your computer, but you can only do that if you pay money for Skype not on the free version. Also on adding people to your call you must have a more advanced version.
