

Learning Targets Revisited



FACTS (Students will know)

1. Students will know the definitions of the fundamental economic systems. INCOMPLETE

Students will know the definitions of capitalism, communism and socialism. CORRECT

2. Students will know formulas for common substances. INCOMPLETE

Students will know the formulae for water (H_2O), Salt ($NaCl$) and Ammonia (NH_3). CORRECT

CONCEPTS (Students will understand)

1. Students will understand the idea of equivalence. TOO LARGE

Students will understand that equivalence means that the quantities on each side of an equation must be equal to each other. MORE REFINED

2. Students will understand the themes in *The Catcher in the Rye*. TOO LARGE

Students will begin to develop their understanding of the theme of adolescent rebellion in *The Catcher in the Rye*. BETTER

Students will understand that the theme of adolescent rebellion in *The Catcher in the Rye* focuses on Holden's perception that most adults are inauthentic and dishonest. MUCH BETTER / MORE REFINED

SKILLS (Students will be able to) (“introduced” or “practiced”)

1. Students will be able to write a five paragraph essay.

TOO LARGE
Incompletely categorized

Students will be able to write a well-structured paragraph with a topic sentence, supporting details and a concluding statement. (practiced)

MORE REFINED

CONSIDER APPROPRIATE SCAFFOLDING!

DISPOSITIONS (Students will feel, value, enjoy, appreciate etc.)

1. Students will appreciate Spanish culture.

TOO LARGE

Students will begin to acquire an appreciation of Mexican culture as it is expressed in Washington State.

MORE REFINED

List targets in this order:

Facts
Concepts
Skills
Dispositions

Associate specific EALRs / GLEs / Standards with specific targets (as appropriate) by citing and summarizing the standard after the target.

For example: (History 2.2: Understand how ideas and technological developments influence people, culture, and environment)

Note: You do not have to have targets from all four target categories on any given LP. In most cases you should limit yourself to a small number of targets (2-5).
