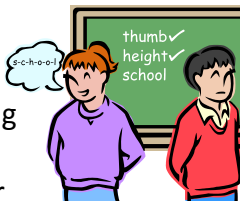

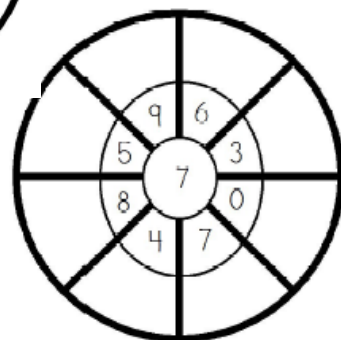
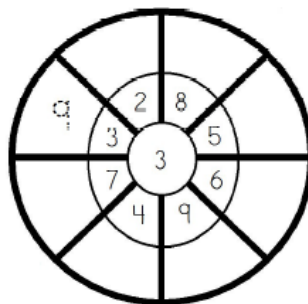
Spelling

Read the following sentences and write your answers in your book.

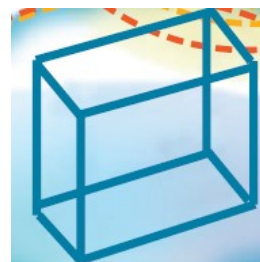
1. On a house, why might a pyramid-shaped roof be better than a flat roof?
