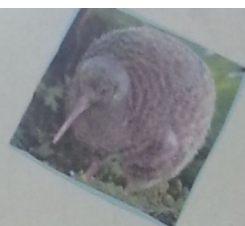

Kiwis are nocturnal birds.

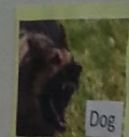
This small flightless bird is the symbol of New Zealand.

Kiwis get eaten by weasels



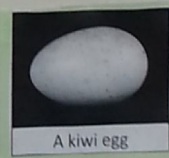
Who is trying to save the kiwis?

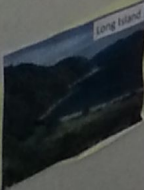
its feathers are fuzzy, large feet and its nose is found at the tip of its beak.
