General Statement

Storm petrels are New Zealand birds and they are endangered.

What do storm petrels eat?

They eat puffins and fish.

Where do storm petrels live?

They are found in the bushes.

Storm petrels are seabirds.

How did the storm petrel become endangered?

Human activities made the storm petrel endangered.

Like many species of seabirds nesting is highly protracted with incubation taking up to 50 days and fledging another 70 days.

Storm petrels are unable to cope with predators like rats and feral cats.

How does a storm catch food?

It swims by the sea and uses its beak to catch the fish.

What are people doing to help the storm petrel?

People are helping the storm petrels by giving them fish and puffins.

Storm petrels feed on planktonic crustaceans and small fish picked from the surface typically while hovering.
