


## Novel terms

7th grade

1. climax - when the main character succeeds or fails  
lives or dies, high pt., turning pt.
2. conflict - problem in the story  
man vs. man  
man vs. nature  
man vs. self
3. irony - the opposite of what you expect happens.
4. dramatic irony - the reader knows what will happen before the characters.
5. Plotline  

  - 1. intro or exposition
  - 2. rising action (conflict)
  - 3. climax
  - 4. falling action
  - 5. conclusion or resolution
6. foreshadow - "sneak preview" clues that something will happen before it does.
7. narrator - the person telling the story
8. point of view - from whose view we are told the story.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> person's pt. of view = "I"
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> person's pt. of view = "he, she, they"
9. omniscient pt. of view - all knowing (we follow almost all the characters around.)
10. limited omniscient - follow one person around.
11. protagonist - central character

- 12. mood - feelings shown through character setting
- 13. tone - authors attitude toward his story
- 14. theme - universal truth or message author is sending
- 15. Flashback - something that happened in the past is told in detail
