4. The mood is the feeling developed through the characters and setting.

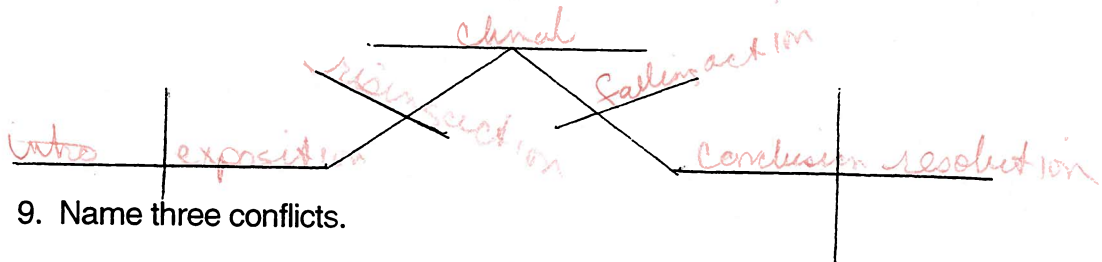
