Essential Questions

- *What is a legacy?*
- *What are the legacies of the Protestant Reformation?*



Project Description:

- *Students will learn about the importance of a **legacy** in history through the study of the Reformation in AP European History.*
- *Students will produce a Mind Map incorporating Causes/Effects and important Reformers' significance*
- *Students will conduct interviews assuming dual personas-as Reformation players*
- *Students will create one legacy art piece-1st Reformation player in an art movement style and a personal "selfie". Both with legacy statements.*
- *Art pieces will be curated throughout the school locations.*
- *Outside experts will be utilized for modeling interviewing skills and art movements*

Incorporating The 5 C's

Critical Thinking and Collaboration-Students create Connectivity Mind Map of Reformation Legacies.

Communication-Students conduct interviews assuming personas of Reformation Players.

Creativity and Citizenship-Students will create one art piece-Reformation Player in an art movement style with legacy statement(s) and "selfie" with personal legacy statement(s).
